- *Appeal: Decisions can be appealed before the Supreme Court Chamber*

 Reserve: Mr. Mong Monichariya (Cam.), Mr. Martin Karopkin (UN)

- *Voting: Affirmative vote of 5 Judges*
- *Serves as both appellate chamber and final instance*
- *Appeal: final decisions on both issues of law and fact, i.e. the case is not to be returned to the Trial Chamber*

Co-Investigating Judge (UN)

Mr. Marcel Lemonde - Reserve: to be announced

- *conduct investigations on the basis of information from any institution, including the Royal Government of Cambodia, UN organs, or NGOs*
- *obligation to consider both incriminating and exculpatory evidence*
- *power to question suspects and victims, to hear witnesses, and to collect evidence in accordance with procedures in force*
- *adjudicate temporary detention and decide whether or not to indict*
