
**NOTING** the Invitation from the Special Panel to the Supreme Court Chamber Judges who adjudicated Case 002/01, dated 22 January 2020.

**ACCORDINGLY**, I, Judge Chandra Nihal **JAYASINGHE** make this brief written submission.

**IN ACCORDANCE WITH** the provisions of Internal Rule 34(2) a judge is subject to disqualification where it is **shown** that “the Judge has a personal or financial interest or concerning which the Judge has, or has had, any association which objectively might affect his or her impartiality, or objectively give rise to the appearance of bias”. I neither have, nor have had, any such interest(s) or bias.

**I FURTHER SUBMIT THAT** as a professional Judge, I am aware and mindful of my obligation to exercise my judicial functions in accordance with and respect for the rule of law, ensuring that the fair trial rights of the accused are observed, ably acting independently, impartially and rigorously in the fair adjudication of cases brought before me. In ensuring the professional integrity of my position as a Judge, decisions in which I am involved are based on a genuine and objective assessment of the law and facts.
