### Hereby inform

Mr. Aom An alias TA An, 79 years of age, of Cambodian nationality and a native of Taing Svay village (today Changva Real), Peam commune, Samaky Meanchy district of Kampong Chhnang province (Cambodia), residing in O'Koky village in Au Da commune of Kamrieng district, Battambang province (Cambodia),

- 1. That he is named as a suspect in the ongoing judicial investigation initiated by the Co-Prosecutor's Introductory Submission dated 20 November 2008 and the Supplementary Submission dated 18 July 2011, for planning, instigating, ordering, aiding and abetting or committing, individually or by participating in a joint criminal enterprise, the following crimes under the jurisdiction of the ECCC:
  - A. Homicide, Torture and Religious Persecution of Cham (Articles 209, 210, 500, 501,503, 504, 505, 506, 507 and 508 of the 1956 Penal Code), punishable under Articles 3 (new), 29 (new) and 39 (new) of the ECCC Law.
  - B. Violations of the Convention on the Prevention and and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide of 1948, punishable under Article 4, 29 (new) and 39 (new) of the ECCC Law.
  - C. Murder; Extermination; Enslavement; Imprisonment; Torture; Rape; Persecutions on political, racial and religious grounds and other Inhumane Acts, which constitute Crimes Against Humanity, punishable under Article 5, 29 (new) and 39 (new) of the ECCC Law;
  - D. Wilful Killing, Wilfully Causing Great Suffering or Serious Injury to Body or Health, Unlawful Transportation, Deportation or Confinement of Civilians, constituting Grave Breaches of the Geneva Conventions of 12 August 1949, punishable under Article 6, 29 (new) and 39 (new) of the ECCC Law.

based on offences committed from 1977 to 1979 in Cambodia as Secretary of Sector 41 and as Deputy Secretary of the Central Zone, responsible for security in Sectors 42 and 43. The high number of victims attests to the gravity of the crimes with which he is charged.

- 2. That these charges are based on both the facts alleged by the co-prosecutors and those uncovered thus far during the course of the investigation.
- 3. That in accordance with the law, he shall be presumed innocent as long as his guilt has not been established, and that we remain available to hear evidence from him relating to these charges should he so wish.
- 4. That in accordance with the Internal Rules of the ECCC [Rule 21(1)(d)], procedural rights and guarantees attached to the status of Suspect notably include the right to be defended by a lawyer of his/her choice, to have access to the case file (application, by

analogy, of Rules 55(6), 55(1) and 58, except for the provisions of Rule 58(6) of the ECCC) and to remain silent at every stage of the proceedings.

5. We advise him, as necessary, to refer to the ECCC's Defence Support Section, whose function is to provide him with assistance in preparing his defence. It can also provide him with a list of counsels kept available for all those entitled to legal assistance before the ECCC.
