- 1. On 16 August 2018, two Closing Orders were issued in Case 004/02: a Dismissal Order issued by the National Co-Investigating Judge¹ and an Indictment issued by the International Co-Investigating Judge.² The Dismissal Order was issued in Khmer with no English translation, while the Indictment was issued in English with no Khmer translation.
- 2. The Co-Prosecutors seek clarification as to when any notice of appeal of one or both Closing Orders would be due given that there are two closing orders for the same case. Both of the Co-Prosecutors believe that in order to make an informed decision on any appeal, they need to review both documents in a language they fully comprehend. Moreover, given that both Closing Orders are lengthy (each over 400 pages), the Co-Prosecutors require some time to evaluate the Closing Orders and the ramifications of any appeal.
- 3. Accordingly, the Co-Prosecutors respectfully request that the deadline applicable to all parties for any notice of appeal related to either Closing Order be extended to 14 days after translations of both Closing Orders have been notified.
- 4. This approach will have the additional benefit of putting all parties on an equal procedural footing, as all notices of appeal of either Closing Order will be due on the same date. The Co-Prosecutors submit that length of the Closing Orders and their interrelationship are exceptional circumstances justifying this extension.³
