The Internal Rules (Rule 23 *quinquies*) permit the Civil Parties to seek moral and collective reparations.

The Civil Parties Group 3 hold the view that, while all the forms of moral reparation (public apologies by the Accused, their admission as civil parties, etc...) are useful and necessary, they are not sufficient.

Collective reparations should likewise be granted, as are the only means to educate the younger generations and to honour the memory of the deceased, Duch's victims.

That is what will contribute to national reconciliation and enable the victims, irrespective of their origin, to experience some closure.

Following the appeal, the Association of Victims of Democratic Kampuchea (Ksem Ksan), which includes all the victims in Case No. 001, made a proposal for collective reparation, which Group 3 (*Avocats Sans Frontières France*) hereby submits for your consideration (see annex).

The reparation is collective and through its realisation, by the victims themselves, it will help the victims experience closure and to feel empathy for one another, as the case is about to come to a close.

Mentioning the proposal in the upcoming decision will constitute an adequate form of reparation and recognition.
