**I, JUDGE KONG SRIM,** President of the Supreme Court Chamber of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia for the Prosecution of Crimes Committed during the Period of Democratic Kampuchea between 17 April 1975 and 6 January 1979;

**NOTING** that on 16 November 2018 the Trial Chamber pronounced its verdict and sentence in Case 002/02 by providing an oral summary of its findings and the disposition of the judgment;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** that the written judgment was subsequently issued in Khmer, French and English on 28 March 2019 ("Trial Judgment");<sup>2</sup>

**BEING SEISED** of appeals against the Trial Judgment lodged by the Co-Prosecutors<sup>3</sup> and KHIEU Samphân;<sup>4</sup>

**PURSUANT** to Internal Rule 108(5), <sup>5</sup> according to which the President of the Supreme Court Chamber shall appoint national and international judges to be corapporteurs to review and give the Chamber full information on the appeals;

**CONSIDERING** the large number of issues raised in the appeals, it is in the interests of effective management to appoint co-rapporteurs for several sets of issues arising from the appeals;<sup>6</sup>
