THE SUPREME COURT CHAMBER of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia for the Prosecution of Crimes Committed during the Period of Democratic Kampuchea between 17 April 1975 and 6 January 1979 ("Supreme Court Chamber" or "ECCC", respectively);

HAVE RECEIVED a filing of "Civil Party Lead Co-Lawyers' Urgent Request to File in One Language and For an Expedited Filing Schedule" ("Urgent Request"); 1

**NOTING** that the Urgent Request is prompted by a matter "concerning a decision of the Office of Administration" that is urgent as it could go into effect at the end of October 2021;<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** that the Urgent Request aims to "address misunderstandings by the Office of Administration regarding the framework for civil party representation under the Internal Rules"; and seeks "an order for the Office of Administration to ensure the continued provision of resources sufficient for the Lead Co-Lawyers to provide effective representation";<sup>4</sup>

## **HAVING FULLY CONSIDERED** the Urgent Request;

**CONSIDERING** that the Supreme Court Chamber is vested with appeal jurisdiction on matters of law and fact under the ECCC legal framework and jurisprudence;

**CONCLUDES** that the Urgent Request involves an administrative decision within the Office of Administrations' authority and is therefore not a justiciable issue and further, the urgent request does not fall within the Supreme Court Chamber's jurisdiction.
