Summary:

This is the first confession of Hak Seang Lay Ny typed on December 25, 1976 and read for confirmation on December 26, 1976 (p.17). Based on the confession, Hak Seang Lay Ny used to pursue his study in the former Soviet Union (p.5).

This document was first examined by Duch on December 28, 1976. Duch jotted down notes for Angkar reading: "Dear respected Brother, based on the confession, eventhough he [confessor] tried to implicate other people, the answer still reflects an evolution to some extent. [I] Directly sent it to you as informative accounts" (p.4). After the examination, Duch sent the document to Khieu (Son Sen) for further examination. Then, Khieu jotted down notes on the document reading: "1) he hasn't confessed all things. He still implicates others for partial amnesty. He said he supposed that Kampuchean Communist Party was not against Soviet Union. Essentially, he confessed that he committed traitorous act by joining the KGB. Further investigation should be launched. Maybe he knows a lot of things, but he also can be untrustworthy; 2) his answer implicated names of certain students [who graduated] from the Soviet Union. Propose Angkar to make an additional examination. The following documents will need more clarification and measures are to be taken" (p.4).

Based on this notification, Khieu might have jotted down notes and sent them to someone, and he/she might have, in turn, sent the document to another person of authority. It is for this reason that there are notes of Nuon Chea (who has been suspected of having jotted down the notes) reading: "Already read, December 29, 1976" (p.4). This claim is based on the fact that there are three different styles of manual scripts, that is the scripts of Duch with signature, Khieu (Son Sen) and of Nuon Chea. Sometimes, Khieu's scripts appear with his signature.
