The Problem of Leaflets that Were Picked Up

- They were picked up on the night of 7 September 1976 ... on the street near Voat Botum, east of Voat Botum. There were 12 leaflets. ...

Comrade Pâng's Surmise:

.... The contents of the leaflets were the same as those that they threw before near the Chinese Embassy. They were done by the same human beings. For instance, the vocabulary: you eat little if you are nobody and eat big if you are somebody; and new, pure Revolutionary Organization.

- That same night from eight to nine, somebody played a tape the contents of which were that the Army must implement the Party's dictatorship. ...

Comrade Pin:

After this phenomenon the last time with this unit of organization, it was transferred and replaced with a new unit of organization on this front. There had previously been problems with this unit, persons from it having taken the Organization's rice when it first arrived. Previously, Comrade Sân gave political education to the brothers and sisters, two or three days after the event.

Comrade Duch:

With regard to those linked to the previous leaflets, we arrested the contemptible Sâmbat. We questioned the contemptible Leat and the contemptible Mat, who said that the leaflets came from Phuon of Division 170. My surmise is that they could have thrown a lot of leaflets on other fronts as well, but the brothers and sisters never paid much heed to this matter.

Brother 89:

1. The contents of these leaflets are identical and the apparatus [behind them] is identical. We are in unity on this point.

2. Were they thrown nearby because that's where they grasped the situation?

3. Or did they also throw them in places further away?

It's necessary to examine units of 170, units of 703 and other units that are camped in the vicinity.

Brother 89:

1. An examination of the contents shows that they are like those in June and July as well. These leaflets were produced nearby, in Phnom Penh. They were produced where it was possible for them to work legitimately, like in a division or regimental office or some ministry.

2. This is not a problem coming from the outside.

3. The concept may of come from the outside or nearby but outside the Army.

4. A lot of the links are connected to Division 170, either in that unit of organization currently or 170s that were sent to Industry, or 220s that the contemptible Li Phal inserted. Or 703s coming from Sector 25 or who are at the State Agricultural Site, links from Sector 25.

5. In order to be able to throw them, they had to be able to grasp the daily and hourly routine situation. Therefore, they are nearby or those in our bodyguard units provided them with information. The enemy wants us no longer to trust units of 703 and 180. ...

6. ... These activities are part of an overall enemy plan. We have to be on guard against an enemy assassination of the Organization

Measures

1. Heighten the outlook of revolutionary vigilance in view of the increasingly very sharp contradictions and the ever strong class hatred of the enemies of the Kampuchean revolution, both the enemy to the West and the enemy to the East. ...

2. In terms of organizational problems, Comrades Pâng and Khammey must recognize their heavy duties and go all out in doing constant political and ideological education. They must firmly grasp biographies and ideologies Externally, Comrade Pin is to reexamine his unit of organization

- As for Security, I suggest that it increase its surveillance of enemy situations.

- I suggest Comrade Pâng liaise with the various ministries. The 170s should be rounded up in one place.
