Presented with Respect to Beloved and Missed Brother

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On 12 July the Command assigned three militaries to take this report to the Sector. Upon arriving at the fork in the road at Choam Khsan this guy named Yeuang, one of the three taking the report, shot the other two friends who were accompanying him on foot, killing one and wounding the other, whom he beat up and whose gun he took and then fled. The surmise is that this guy Yeuang is also linked with the ten persons above, and all of them are links of the contemptible Yot and the contemptible Yeuang who were already smashed, as previously reported. CIA pacification agents made contact with these guys from Thailand via this very Preah Vihear temple corridor. This is the Sector's preliminary conclusion. There will be a further detailed investigation. Among these eleven guys, one was a Party member and a team chairman. They had taken documents with them on their persons, six editions of *Banners of Revolution*. They had stuck into a tree stump two leaflets the contents of which attacked the Communist regime for eliminating tradition, for non-stop work, and for rationing rice by the can. They were appealing to our militaries to smash cadre and to no longer live with Communists without freedom, ranks or salaries. The enemy trick was that three days before this traitorous Party member the contemptible Yeuang fled he whipped up a line in his team to get it to go constantly back and forth transporting rice to Preah Vihear. He whipped up a criticism movement to the effect that this was really an enormous storming attack, and then once the scare was into them, he put an interpretation on things to the effect that even though they were working non-stop the Organization would still say they weren't doing things right.
