Telegramme Dated 23 September 1976

To Beloved and Missed Comrade Reuan

1. According to the data, the revisionist enemies and the Sevens are conducting liaison activities in order to go undercover and bore from within our army and grassroots.

At the same time, they are in contact with some traitors in order to be able to whip up the people to oppose cooperatives and oppose our line of socialist revolution. In general terms, their speciality is protracted undercover boring from within.

2. Therefore, it is imperative to take the following measures:

1. It is imperative to educate the whole Division Committee so that it internalizes such enemy tricks.

2. It is imperative to maintain surveillance of any elements who have had contact with the Sevens or who tend to prefer the Sevens, in order to purge them, so that they do not hold leadership positions in the army at any level whatsoever.

3. With regard to the comrades who have represented the Division and have had duties in Committees of Liaison with the Sevens, you must help keep constant track of them ideologically, and it is imperative frequently to change these elements. Don't keep on with the same comrades.

The experience with the Sevens is that they're always trying to win over our Liaison Committees to serving their policy of aggression against Kampuchea. In some places, they've gotten somewhere with these contacts.

It is therefore imperative to be careful and absolutely not allow them to bore from within among either cadre or combatants, and in particular absolutely not to allow them to have any contact whatsoever with the Divisions along the border.

It's also absolutely prohibited for our army to have any contacts along the border with Viet Nam. The Sevens are undercover in Laos, as you are already aware, Comrade. They could bore in via Laos, too. ...
