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Comrade Mēt ម៉ែត៖

1. Enemy situation on 16 September. One carbine was hidden at the 502nd Division School, which was preparing to convene a class. The weapon was loaded. The conclusion is that the enemy had intended to kill our cadres during studies.

- In Battambang, the Zone troops defending the airfield had bad elements, which the bases have already taken measures to screen out. At the fuel depot, candy wrappers have appeared in the fuel. Someone put broken bottle-glass on the aircraft runway.

2. Food production situation – 410 hectares of light rice were planned. Only 375 hectares have been transplanted due to shortage of seedlings. The causes: little was sown, some was replanted in bad spots, and what was sown did not grow very well. The 502nd concludes in general that light rice will yield 1.5 tons per hectare. It is especially important that the grass must be pulled to get large yields.

- There are 1151 hectares of heavy rice, 688 hectares already transplanted. [We] can attack only 20 hectares per day, because transplanting sites have not yet been made. There is a possibility this may be finished on 10 October.

3. Water situation: At the 502nd spearheads, water was not emphasized heavily, but if water is blocked up above to protect the 703rd, there will be some impact. But the land of the 703rd is better, and that harvest must be protected.

4. Health situation - The brothers and sisters have strange illnesses, mostly swelling, but not impacting life and death. The problem does not arise from food, but rather from [a lack of] hygiene at living sites.

5. Food supply situation - The units will be out in late September.

6. Party situation - Through frequently meetings and studies, progress is seen in the task of continuing socialist revolution, not showing face, rank, or any major liberalism. In building socialism, most are good and active, but some individuals are holding back. One company cadre guarding female enemy/enemies was accused of sexual involvement. One other company cadre beat a combatant seriously when he saw the combatant walking to transplanting.

On leadership, after the conference, cadres were seen to go down close [to the masses] but some seemingly [just] observing, not getting their clothes dirty.

Comrade Muth ម៉ុត៖

1. Enemy situation - Since early September there have been major changes. The Thais have increasingly sneaked into the fisheries in our waters. They come in convoys

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of fishing boats, up to 100 or 150. They mostly entered in the vicinity of Koh Kong and the Koh Tang gap. On 11 September, we captured one 50 horsepower boat.

- Vietnam - the sea border. When we approach near to the sea demarcation line, they always open fire. Now we will remember this, and if they approach the line, we will fire on them too.

- On the mainland, in early September, thievery appeared, stealing anything. One company cadre had his pistol stolen by the enemy while sleeping at night. There has been incitement that there are tigers. Seven combatant drivers organized a liberal unit with a commissar and a commander, and someone responsible for their logistics. At Kâng Kēng កងកេង there had been thievery, mostly appearing in military elements.

2. Food production situation - By 20 August, all the transplanting was completed, both light and heavy rice. By 30 August, 30 hectares of light rice was harvested with a yield of 50 bushels per hectare. Almost 300 hectares of middle rice [ស្រូវកណ្តាល ordinary rice] were grown, and by approximately 10 October it will be sent out. 1,600 hectares of heavy rice has been transplanted by both the army and the people; the total force of both troops and people was 17,000. The rice harvest was exactly two tons over an area of 2,000 hectares, short by 61,000 bushels.

3. Health situation - In September, many brothers and sisters had fevers, but it has not yet had a life and death impact. The cause is much rain, and the brothers and sisters don't have much rain clothing.

4. Food supply situation - Calculating through 15 November, the new rice which has arrived will be exhausted. Food supplies on the islands will be exhausted in January 77. Secondary crops on the mainland have mostly rotted. There are 30 hectares of potatoes in the ground.

5. Party situation - During the past several months, there has been no expansion, just strengthening. [We] have indoctrinated to an extent on the task of continuing socialist revolution and the task of national defense well. On the islands, the brothers and sisters have pushed vegetable growing for self-support. The Party on the islands has a certain extent of mastery. The shortfall is that cadres do not have constant control of the forces. Example - Combatants and cadres who come to stay in the hospitals walk around freely, not kept under control.

- On the mainland - The majority of cadres have absorbed about continuing socialist revolution, but have not yet actually gone down close [to the masses], mostly they just have gone down to dawdle around. Some cadres deceive their subordinates by saying that Angkar has called them to meetings, and then they sneak around riding their motorcycles for fun.

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Comrade Sokh សុខ -

1. Enemy situation – As for external enemies, there has been nothing strange, just some people walking around freely. That has been resolved.

2. Food production situation - 400 hectares of light rice must be transplanted. Now 324 hectares has been transplanted. The seedlings are short, the water deep, and transplanting has fallen behind.

369 hectares of heavy rice have been transplanted. There is a possibility that transplanting will not be completed by 10 October. Previously, 30 hectares could be transplanted per day. Now, only 15 hectares can be transplanted per day, because there is so much grass. As of today, 30 hectares are flooded.

Of 15 hectares of ripe light rice, only one hectare has been harvested, but the rats have eaten a lot.

3. Flood waters - Request agreement to let it flood, so as not to damage the rice at Cheung Ek ជើងឯក.

4. Health - Forty percent of the brothers and sisters are sick with swelling, diarrhea, malaria. Ten have died this month. The cause is due to drinking paddy water where fertilizer has been spread.

5. Food supplies - On 15 October, the rice will be gone. Only corn will remain. But in September, 12 hectares of light rice will ripen, and this may resolve [the problem]. There are secondary crops in spots; the brothers and sisters have grown vegetables.

6. Party situation - The cadres and Party members understand and have absorbed socialist revolution, and have actually gone down to mix [with the masses]. Due to confusion in the units, the cadres don't dare lead much, have no mastery, and just wait for the division's plans.

Comrade Pheap ភិណ -

1. Enemy situation - There is nothing strange surrounding the units. After the bad elements were removed, it has been quiet. There is only thievery.

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2. Food production situation - Eight hectares of light rice harvested, yielding 2.8 tons per hectare. The krâmuon sâ rice is thick; if it can all be maintained, it may make three tons. There are 243 hectares of heavy rice. An additional 80 hectares of land has not yet transplanted.

3. Flood waters - No water is entering from the rivers and streams, there is just water from where the people have pierced [dikes] not knowing where it would flow, which has led to flooding.

4. Health - More than 100 brothers and sisters are sick. Most of the sick brothers and sisters are from new units. During September, nine died.

5. Food supplies - The old rice will be exhausted by the end of September. As for secondary crops, there are none that are old, there are just new crops.

6. Party matters - There is no expansion, just strengthening. Party Members have not received much building, most [only] having discussions inside life style groups.

Comrade Tâl តាល់ -

1. Enemy situation - Outside there is nothing strange, but at 2 PM on 18 September, gunfire was heard in the vicinity of Prêk Thmei ព្រែកថ្មី.

2. Food production situation

- There are 175 hectares of light rice; five hectares are entirely flooded. There are ten hectares of ripe light rice, and 29 hectares are ripening. 93 hectares are getting ready.

- There are 500 hectares of heavy rice. There is possibility that by the end of September it will have been completed.

3. Flood waters - 100 hectares of rice have been knotted up by the water, but not yet ruined.

4. Health - In September, the number of people ill from diseases increased to 100, but in comparison to last year the diseases were not of serious types.

5. Food - Old food supplies may solve things until mid October. As for secondary crops, corn is short of the estimated 400 tons; there are only 200 tons.

6. Party matters - There has been no recent expansion, just strengthening the stance of continuing socialist revolution. Progress has been seen in weakening

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ownership, rank, and face [status]. In building socialism [cadres] have mixed and been active, but some cadres just go down to observe.

Comrade Huy ហ៊ុយ -

1. Enemy situation - During the past month, nothing important stands out, just running off, inciting conflicts, but that too has been dealt with continually.

2. Food production situation -

- The number of hectares of ripe light rice now being harvested is not yet clearly known. 40 hectares of rice came out well. 15 hectares of light rice yielded three tons per hectare. About 25 hectares yielded two tons.

- 217 hectares of heavy rice have been transplanted, but 20 hectares have flooded. Another 90 hectares has not yet been transplanted, but the water is too deep.

3. Flood waters - In comparison to last year, it has not yet reached previous levels. River and stream waters are down. If there is strong rain water flooding, it will be difficult to hold it back and protect Cheung Ek.

4. Health - There are 400 persons sick, but none have died yet.

5. Food supply situation - There is nothing to solve it, just a dependence on light rice, that's all.

6. Party situation - After strengthening, there has been much progress. Shortfalls: There is not yet a high level of vigilance in the work; it is still disorderly.

Comrade Oeun ឃីន -

1. Enemy situation - There is nothing strange regarding outside enemies. After arresting a boy at Prék Kdam ប្រែកក្តាម, the [cadres] inside have discovered a number of traitors in the units, according to [prisoner] responses from the outside and according to the actual situation. Thievery continues. After reeducation, most of the good ones reform themselves, but a few are stubborn, argue, and do not reform. The problem of stealing appears to be a policy, not ordinary theft, like the theft of 200 kilograms of rice.

2. Food production situation -

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- 278 hectares of light rice have been transplanted; four hectares have been harvested, yielding 4 ½ tons per hectare. 15 hectares are ripening. [We are] not keeping up with the 400 hectare plan, due to young seedlings.

- There are 837 hectares of heavy rice; 35 hectares are very weak. 20 hectares have flooded; there may be no hope for the future. The yield may be three tons per hectare over 50 percent of the land. The possibility of achieving the plan by 10 October is unspecified.

3. Flood waters - Since 14 September, there has been serious flooding in the vicinity of Chhouk Va ឈូកវ៉ា, but [we are] dealing with by pumping it out.

4. Health - 2,600 brothers and sisters are sick, of whom 400 are seriously ill and cannot work. A doctor who was an enemy network used only sleeping pills; whatever they were ill with, he gave them sleeping pills. In the 13th Regiment, someone poisoned food with ghost beans, making the brothers and the sisters in the group sick. This month seven persons in the special unit and the artillery unit died. The causes: mosquito bites, drinking dirty water, and living in malarial areas like Kâp Srauv កាប់ស្រាវ, Poun Phnom ពួនភ្នំ.

5. Food supplies - All food supplies will have been eaten during this September.

6. Party situation - After reeducation, there has been strong internal struggle. Part of the Party members and cadres are not yet loyal and are looking to betray the Party, unsatisfied and unhappy with the Four Year Plan of the Party.

Comrade Suong ស្បង់ -

1. Enemy situation - There has been nothing strange on external enemies, but internally there are still liberal phenomena. There may be enemies in the units, but we reeducate strongly and they are quiet.

2. Food production situation -

- 357 hectares of light rice have been transplanted. Average yield may be over one ton per hectare. 55 hectares of light rice are ripe, and may be harvested in early October. 84 hectares are blooming.

- 610 hectares of heavy rice have been transplanted. Three ton yields may be gained on only 20 percent of the area. Only 50 percent has been transplanted, due to a shortage of seedlings. There is a possibility it may be transplanted during October.

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3. Flood waters – 35 hectares of rice, both light and heavy, has flooded. Boeng Pea Bèn បឹងព្រៃបែន has been heavily flooded. Measures: flowing toward Comrade Nai's ណៃ spearhead.

4. Health - There are 300 people sick at the division hospital. Including those at the regiments, there are 1,000 sick. The illnesses are like those in the other divisions. From mid August to mid September, nine brothers and sisters have died of illnesses.

5. Food supply situation – During September, all [food supplies] have been drawn from General Staff Logistics; there are no food supplies of our own. There are no old stocks of secondary crops, and most of the crops have rotted from water damage.

6. Party situation - Inside, nothing has yet appeared in opposition to the Party. After disseminating information and reeducation, Party Members and cadres have gone down close to the work, and have gone down close to the masses. There are deficiencies, providing misguided opinions leading to conflicts and dissatisfaction. Regimental and battalion cadres have strived even harder to build one another and are livelier than before, not sitting around in comfort.

Comrade Pin ពិន -

1. Enemy situation – During the night of 16 September at the Industry Office, someone entered the house of Brother Say សាយ. [We] attempted to surround, but could not capture.

2. Food supply situation -

- Of the planned 300 hectares of light rice, 301 hectares has been transplanted. 27 hectares of ripe rice is being selected for harvest.

- 529 hectares of heavy rice have been transplanted. There is a possibility it may all be transplanted within the next twenty days.

3. Flood waters - The water keeps on flowing from upstream. Presently, 25 hectares are flooded. If it is held upstream, Comrade Sokh សុខ and Comrade Huy ហ៊ុយ will be flooded.

4. Health - More than 400 persons are ill.

5. Food supplies - Reportedly enough for October. Now, in fact, [we] may self-support only until 20 October, because of a dependence on insufficient corn.

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6. Party matters - After studies, it has been seen that the Party Members understand more clearly than before about continuing to make socialist revolution, and don't have strong face and rank [attitudes]. Shortfalls were two company cadres with face and rank conflicts. Building socialism while on a strong offensive to produce food, some platoon cadres were muddled.

Comrade Hin ហ៊ិន -

1. Enemy situation - Nothing strange.
2. Food production - There are 30 hectares of light rice. 17 hectares have come out well. 82 hectares of heavy rice has been transplanted. Four hectares have flooded. 45 hectares have not yet been transplanted.
3. Health - 25 persons are sick, among them five are swollen.
4. Food supplies - Old rice may last until October. Secondary crops are only the new crops.
5. Party situation - As examined before the conference, there were some hindrances. After the conference, there have been some progressive changes and active food production.

Comrade Sim ស៊ីម -

1. Enemy situation - There has been nothing strange on external enemies. In the units, on 12 September two combatants deserted.
2. Food production situation - Ten hectares of light rice have been harvested, eight hectares are blooming, six hectares are getting ready. Total of 110 hectares have been transplanted. More than ten hectares of rice have flooded near Watt Russei Sănh វត្តបុស្សីសាញ់.
3. Health - Six male and female combatants died during August and September. A symptom of the disease was coughing up blood.
4. Food supply situation - Supplies may last until 30 November.

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5. Party situation - After studies from the conference on the Party Statutes, there has been a progressive movement. The cadres and Party Members have gone down close to the labor. There is nothing worrying about rank and face.

Comrade Tin ១៩ -

1. Enemy situation - In the rice field spearheads, 30 cans of paddy rice disappeared; a white dog was seen at the paddy rice site.

2. Food production situation - There is no light rice. 316 hectares of heavy rice were previously reported to Angkar. Twelve hectares of rice have flooded.

3. There are no flood countermeasures; the water just keeps on going up every day.

4. Health - At the regimental hospital, there are more than 100 persons sick. Comrade Hok ហ៊ុក is seriously ill at Hospital P17 [៧.១៧].

5. Food supply situation - There are no shortages. Eating food supplies issued by Angkar.

6. Party situation - After reeducation, Party Members have prospered and have gone down to mix closely with the people. Some cadres and Party Members still appear to be observers. Leadership is not yet firm and absolute, is still in spurts, with no situational grasp.

Brother 81 - According to statistics, food supplies for October have been solved.

There are 220 tons of rice in the warehouses. Paddy rice from the harvest, according to the numbers provided by the divisions, totals 256 tons, for a combined total of 476 tons. The 42,392 persons consuming in November will eat 563 tons plus 177 kilograms. Rice will be short by 85 tons in November.

The summary and opinions of Brother 89 -I. Enemy situation and the task of national defense:

1. As for the external enemy situation, there has been some activity, for instance on the oceans, related to the enemy to the west, and in the East and at Koh Tral កោះត្រល់, related to the enemy to the east. At the same time, [we] have noticed enemy activity inside the country and inside our ranks, stirring up rumors attacking the revolution,

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stirring up rumors that the enemy is attacking us here and attacking us there, defecating activities, stealing rice, knocking on doors at night, throwing dirt clods, pretending to be dogs, pretending to be tigers. These are CIA activities.

2. Two major enemy activity networks:

First, the American-French-Taiwanese imperialist network. They pretend to request to enter the country legally, and they secretly enter and hide along the Thai border. They began attacking us in June 76. Their plans are to attack and totally liberate [the country] in 1980. They ambush and shoot at cadres, and secretly destroy at our fuel storage depots, air fields, and factories.

Second, The Soviet-Vietnamese revisionist network wants to attack us in 1980, like the CIA. This network strives to expand and imbed inside the army and inside the bases to attack our revolution.

These networks are connected on attacking us. For instance, the network of Chäkrei ཅཱཾྱཾྲི was CIA, but they made close contact with the revisionist networks in the bases. Sector 24 and Sector 25 are connected to Vietnam. They have gathered up some cadres who have rank and face conflicts. They cooperated near and far to smash our leadership apparatus in April 76. At the same time, they carry out minor activities, political and military spying.

What are their activities?

- The enemy to the west. Previously the American bases in Thailand could not attack us. Now, the American bases are gone. Thailand is having internal difficulties and is attacked by the revolution. Thailand is in conflict with Vietnam

- The enemy to the east is in economic difficulty, has capitalist society characteristics, and the CIA is deeply imbedded.

In attacks from the outside, the enemy possibilities are difficult. The thing to be vigilant about is the enemy attacking us from the inside, boring holes inside us.

2. Our countermeasures -

1. In views:

A. [We] must closely grasp the class view and class struggle, and these conflicts are sharper than before. Partially, the imperialists are angry at our revolution, and don't want our revolutionary to become a model for the countries they oppress to follow and lead to the detriment of the imperialists. The revisionists are hot toward us because they have lost hope of controlling us. These conflicts are class conflicts between the revolution and imperialism and revisionism.

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B. [We] must have proper views in conflict resolution, clearly understanding that the enemy is attacking us both from the inside and the outside. But [we must] be most especially vigilant of the enemy attacking from inside by boring holes inside the bases and our army. [We] must counter them by frequent and clear reeducation on the revolutionary line and the Party Statutes.

C. The view which must be seen as a foundation is that the enemy attacks upon us must fail. The enemy is not strong. His important networks have been attacked and smashed by us. But [we] must have the view that the enemy is not all gone, that he continues activities to attack. Therefore do not be non-revolutionarily optimistic at all.

D. We must have the view of countering the enemy, relying upon the power of the masses. Therefore, we must train our Party Members and male and female combatants, so they absorb and understand clearly the trickery and the activities of the enemy, in order that they can counter.

E. [We] must indoctrinate on some forms of enemy activities, so they will understand. If they are enemies, when we reeducate them, they will not stop. If our masses commit offenses or speak wrongly out of confusion or from not understanding, when we reeducate them, they will understand, and they will certainly stop.

2. Organizational measures -

A. [We] must thoroughly organize guards by Party Circulars, and reeducate them to be polite.

B. Inside the army, [we] must reeducate on the situational view [and] enemy trickery and struggle to eradicate face and rank, so that the enemy cannot attract them.

C. [We] must have an absolute stance to screen out counter-revolutionary elements. Do not hesitate.

D. On the ocean, [we] must have through defensive measures, as in the plans we have met on previously.

II. Food production -

1. Transplanting heavy rice: Must push achieving 90 to 100 percent of the plans of each division from during the period from 19 September through 10 October. Whatever units have possibilities must go on strong offensives.

2. Light rice: Propose to stop making three month rice. But in places already harvested, during September [we] must transplant middle [ordinary] rice once more on

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land where mastery has been achieved over water. Especially, make kramuon sâ and seven decimeters variety seed.

3. Protecting and preserving the harvest: Must concentrate on storage, weeding, maintaining fertilizer, adding and caring for water. Any unit out of land to transplant must go on the offensive to pull grass, so that grass will not overgrow the rice. Field rats must be attacked and eradicated to protect the harvest. Kampong Saom must pull plots and draw experience.

4. Countering flood waters: Our views and stances are to absolutely protect the light rice which has come out and is almost ready to eat. If water floods some new transplanting, [we] must dare to sacrifice them and do everything so as not to let any ripe light rice at all become flooded. Ripe parrot-green colored rice must be harvested; do not hesitate, with the exception of rice to be kept for seed.

5. Expanding new land and finding fertile land:

A. Division 290 must put water into reservoirs. Propose planting corn on 200 hectares, and not planting soy bean.

B. For other divisions on land near the river banks, propose preparing to plant all corn.

C. Division 703, propose preparing land along stream banks to get ready for irrigated rice. Just be quick on the matter of water gates.

D. Divisions 310 and 450 must finish preparing drawing of routes for water to drain out to expand fertile land and to expand land for irrigated rice. Before pumping water out, must get all the grass out.

E. Division 170 must turn back to the east to expand fertile land at Boeng Snao បឹងស្នោ. Expand land in order to eradicate rats too. Next year, make kramuon kâ rice.

F. Division 164 absolutely must hold water in the foothills and dam fresh water creeks. [We] must make water reservoirs.

6. Seed : Throughout the country, the two best good rice varieties are kramuon sâ and seven decimeters. These varieties go well with both alluvial soil and ordinary soil.

7. Rice threshing machines: Propose taking them from Industry to thresh and also report for study for experience.

Angkar has decided to provide four water pumps.

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8. Food supplies: Propose closely grasping food supply statistics, because this is a strategic matter in building socialism. Not making statistics comes from the brothers and sisters not yet having the stance of thoroughness in making statistics, and also from ownership ideology, hiding statistics for their personal units. [We] must organize people to be responsible for recording statistics.

9. Health: The view of force protection. The spirit of force protection must be raised high.

A. Propose hygienic measures, digging wells for drinking water, not drinking paddy water.

B. Counter and monitor enemy activities destroying our forces by the use of poisons. Avoid spraying poisons, and [wash] vegetables and food with water.

C. Propose that General Staff hospital invite medics from all divisions to experience summary meetings, but before meeting, go to see the specific locations.

D. Propose contacting Hospital P17 to draw experience. Invite them down to the specific locations.

III. Leadership:

1. Politics and ideology -

A. In national defense matters, must indoctrinate the situational view regarding enemy trickery and enemy activity. [We] must indoctrinate the view of revolutionary vigilance to attack enemy trickery.

B. Indoctrinate the view of making heavy rice to achieve 90 to 100 percent of the plan.

C. Indoctrinate the spirit of collectivism to become higher.

2. Organization -

A. [We] must go down close to lead, not just go down to meetings. [We] must go down to the rice paddies, to the rice, to the water pumps. Go down to see and to listen to reports to be able to summarize experience clearly.

B. Go down close to the Branches, and go down to the rice paddies. Go down to the Branches to lead effectively.

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C. Expanding Party membership. In the current situation, must first take the stance of strengthening. Any unit clearly grasped, if necessary, must expand to fulfill leadership spots in our Party.
