

Interview of Nai Seu, non-Chinese speaking Sino-Khmer, male, age 58, interviewed at hairdresser's, east side of the road, Ta Keo village, Kor subdistrict, Prey Chhor district, Kampong Cham province, 11 November 2006, by Steve Heder with Heng Ham Kheng

My relative, Prüm was a Sector 41 medic, from this village and was killed. The last Sector Security Chairman was named Ngôv, but he fled.

In Sector 41, Sreng was at Prey Toteung, a teacher at Prey Toteung and a native of Ta Meak. Prüm was Vice Chairman of Sector 41 medics, arrested after Sreng.

Tiv Ol and Vanh (alias Sen Hon), who was in the Northwest, were both from Ta Keo. Kâng was from Phsar Kor. Some of his relatives are still alive: Reuan, the younger brother of Kâng.

The Security of Sector 41 was west of the road, of Phsar Kor and Ta Keo. Then there were also lots of little execution sites east of the road, along the stream from Toek Chha.

Ngôv, the last security chief, was from Kang Meas, but was in the Southwest Zone network. He fled in 1979.

The district north of National Route 7 was 77 Loe [upland 77]. South of the road was 77 Kraom [lowland 77].

Söp was the Sector 41 Security Chairman under Sreng and was killed at the same time as Sreng.

If you want to know more, as the people in Krauch village, Krauch subdistrict, who were nearest the Security Office.

Kor-10 was the name of the 77 Loe District Office, on the border of Ta Keo village and Ta Meas. There was no district security office.

Sometimes, people were brought in from Au Trakuon by the truck full to the Security Office.

This was also the area which Hu Nim represented.

I was a cook, but I had relatives in Phnom Penh.

Häh Vari, now an official, was an evacuee here and is now in Phnom Penh as a big shot, an Excellency, at the Ministry of Education.

The Kor-10 District Com in the Sreng period was Buon.

When the Southwest Zoners first arrived, they pretended they didn't know what they were doing, acted dumb, and then once they had power in their hands, they began arresting everybody. They then appointed new cadres.

The executions along the stream east of the road: this was where the Lon Nol soldiers were killed. The execution sites of Söp and Ngôv were west of the road.

Prey Saravoan was another execution site, and old society meditation site. Now that I think of it, it belonged to 77 Loe district.

An executioner who is still alive is now an achar at Voat Kor. He was a *kâng* chairman.

There were lots of evacuees here from Kampung Chamville, and some were killed.

When the Southwest Zoners came, they killed the previous cadres, down to the *me kâng* level, but not ordinary people. The worst killings were in 1978.

Söp was a Prey Toteung teacher, but I don't know his original name.

Krauch village is maybe 1 kilometer west of the road, west of here: enter via the Voat Krauch gateway.

My son here, Hăk Bũn Thân, is a chef at the Intercontinental (tel 029 62 69 92).

Kae Pok visited Kor-10, when Sreng was still in place.
