- **2. O-Gon Kwon** (Board of Editors) Judge at the ICTY since 2001. Sat on the trials of *Prosecutor* v. *Milošević*² and *Prosecutor* v. *Popović et al*, ³ both of which concern JCE.
- **3. Bert Swart** (Board of Editors) Assigned as a Pre-Trial Judge in the case of *Prosecutor v. Milutinović*, which concerned JCE.⁴
