

Additional information related to Case 001 (18.07.2007, ECCC)

Early 1979

The Khmer Rouge arrested 10 of my friends (me included) in Stung Treng and took us to Phnom Penh (we knew each other from our regular Khmer Rouge Cadre meetings)

1. ROMAM Yun (myself), regional deputy-chief of Veun Sai District
2. KLAN Fit, deputy chief of District 21 (Andoung Meas District)
3. Pung, regional deputy chief of District 15, Lumphat District
4. Chea or Pha (from Laos) district secretariat, Chmor District, Stung Treng Province
5. Poy, district secretariat 23
6. Bien, district secretariat 22
7. Yam, district secretariat, Siem Pang District
8. Chhum, chief of the North-East soldiers
9. Tha Vorn (from Laos) Stung Treng regional deputy chief
10. Sovann, Siem Pang District deputy chief

When I arrived to Phnom Penh, the Khmer Rouge kept me in a house for one month, which had a king portrait, a world map and had windows. The Khmer Rouge asked each of us about our past, then we were told to do potato gardening. One month later, four of us (KLAN Fit, ROMAM Yun, Pung and Chea) were separated taken to Wat Sleng (Education Department). The other 6 friends were arrested and taken to Tuol Sleng Prison by the Khmer Rouge and then we never heard from them again.

I would like to complain about the disappearing of my six friends.
