Telegram No.32 on 24 August 1977

Khieu

25 Aug.

Situation along the border: at 10:00 hours on 24 August, two enemy warplanes, one helicopter and one T-28 were flying around along the waterline. At 10:10 hours, these warplanes launched 6 rockets over our territory at beach and mountain cliff in Poy Chămyeam (ព្រៃចាំយាម). At the same time, the enemy fired 35 rounds of 106 mm, 4 rounds of 81 mm and 16 rounds of 60 mm from their land base into the locations identified by their warplanes.

The enemy continued shelling for two hours 400 m deep inside our territory. In response, our defence force fired 2 rounds of 75 mm, 6 rounds of 60 mm, 4 rounds of 82 mm and many rounds of other handguns over the enemy base.

At 22:00 hours, two enemy warships reached along our waterline moving up and down several times. During this fighting, our side did not suffer any damage. A number of enemy rounds were overshoot above our combatants' camp.
