To Respected and Beloved Brother 98

1. From the second step of re-education with regard to activities, it is apparent that the brothers and sisters are getting more and more deeply involved and are more and more powerfully unmasking the former leading cadre. The general situation from the division right down to the battalion level was one of authoritarian repression of the brothers and sisters, of denying them their rights and freedoms, so that they would not engage in struggle or refashioning. It is apparent that there were powerful contradictions between combatants and cadre, who did not think about the living standards of the brothers and sisters.

2. Of the cadre who remain, change has been visible in 92 with regard to Comrade Sãn and Comrade Un, battalion secretaries, when our cadre went down to further reinforce the battalions. However, there's nothing out of the ordinary with regard to the masses. They facilitate us.

3. The state of affairs in the days after education is that 90 per cent or more of the brothers and sisters are more and more concerned that there are traitors.
