My name is Ly Hor. I used the name Ear Hor during the Khmer Rouge regime. I presently live at Phnom Tauch village, Phnom Tauch commune, Mongkul Borey district, Banteay Meanchey province. I have applied to become a civil party in case 001. However, on July 26, 2010, the Trial Chamber has rejected my application.

I am writing this letter to clarify that I do not have additional documents to submit in support of civil party application to the Chamber. I would like to request civil party lawyers representing me to send this letter to the Chamber. I would also like to request that my thumbprint printed on this letter be compared to the thumbprint printed on my confession taken while I was imprisoned at Tuol Sleng.
