Summary of Proceedings

Recognition of international civil party lawyer

Pursuant to Rule 22(2)(a) of the Internal Rules, the Trial Chamber recognized Christine MARTINEAU as civil party lawyer for the purposes of the proceedings before the Chamber.

Reading of the Relevant parts of the Closing Order

The Greffiers read the following relevant paragraphs of the Closing Order for the first phase of the trial: 18 to 32; 862 to 868; 1577 to 1579; 994 to 1000; 1091; 1585 to 1588;

1126 to 1130; and 1598 to 1600.

Agreed facts

The Co-Prosecutors indicated that to their knowledge, there were no agreed facts between the parties. The Chamber reminded the parties of Document E9/21.3 whereby agreed facts were proposed. Co-Prosecutors indicated that they indeed proposed a list of agreed facts to which IENG Sary Defence responded, but there has been no further defence response.

Application by the Defence NUON Chea

1) Admission of documents (E141)

The Defence objected to the documents referred to in the footnotes of the Closing Order as considered to be put before the Chamber. The Defence, however, indicated that it would agree with the Co-Prosecutors' proposition in their consolidated response to its motion concerning the admission of documents.

2) Review of witness's prior statements

The NUON Chea Defence objected to the review of their prior statements by witnesses/civil parties summoned before the Chamber in order to refresh their memories. The Defence considered that no detailed reasoning has been provided for the Chamber's ruling communicated in document E141 and requested the stay of the Chamber's decision, pending a decision on the Defence's oral motion.

IENG Sary Defence application concerning the presence of civil parties and witnesses during the testimonies

The Defence requested that the Chamber indicate whether civil parties/witnesses who have not yet given testimonies are allowed to observe the testimony of other civil parties/witnesses and interact with them. The Lead Co-Lawyers for the civil parties responded to the Defence's request.

Examination of the Accused NUON Chea

The Chamber questioned the Accused NUON Chea.

Recognition of international Defence counsel for KHIEU Samphan

Pursuant to Rule 22(2)(a) of the Internal Rules, the Trial Chamber recognized Arthur VERCKER as Defence lawyer for KHIEU Samphan for the purposes of the proceedings before the Chamber.

Request to add NUON Chea's notes to case file

The Co-Prosecutors requested that NUON Chea's notes relied on during his questioning be placed on the case file. NUON Chea Defence consented. The notes were filed as E148.

Trial Chamber disposition of Defence Applications

1) Admission of documents (E141)

The Chamber indicated that once paragraphs of the Closing Order are read, the documents cited in the footnotes are considered to be put before the court. However, parties will be given an opportunity to raise objections regarding the authenticity of documents. If necessary, the Chamber will schedule hearings to address such objections.

2) Review of witness's prior statements before being summoned by the Chamber

The Chamber indicated that, through WESU, it will provide their prior statements to the summoned witnesses. Witnesses already have access to prior statements, as copies were provided to them when statements were taken. Witnesses will not be permitted to keep their statements after giving testimony.

3) Attendance of Proceedings by Civil Parties, Witnesses, and Experts

The Chamber indicated that Rule 88(2) does not limit the right of civil parties to be present at proceedings. To the extent possible, Witnesses and experts are permitted to observe the testimonies of other witnesses in the public gallery.

Request to adjourn examination until tomorrow

On two occasions, NUON Chea requested to adjourn the examination due to fatigue. The Chamber denied the initial request, but granted the adjournment on the second request.
