SUBJECT: Order for Video-Link Testimony of Civil Party TGC

The Civil Party lawyers have been accorded 4 days to present statements of suffering during the Victim Impact hearing (E236/5). The Lead Co-Lawyers for the Civil Parties have requested that one Civil Party testify by video-link from France (E236/5/3/1.1). The purpose of the Victim Impact hearings is to provide the Civil Parties an opportunity to present evidence relevant to collective and moral reparations (Internal Rule 23(1)(b)) and each Civil Party is scheduled to testify for about 75 minutes. It is within the Chamber's broad discretion whether to hear video-link testimony. In this case, the Chamber considers it unnecessary to transport the Civil Party from France to Cambodia to hear her statement of suffering, considering video-link modalities are available. The Chamber therefore orders the Civil Parties to facilitate TCCP-13's statement of suffering by video-link from France. WESU is directed to make all necessary arrangements in conjunction with the relevant authorities to prepare the video-link testimony on 29 May 2013.
