#### Summary of Proceedings

### Issues concerning medical examinations of the Accused

The Counsel for NUON Chea explained that he had not attempted to interfere with the medical examination of Mr. NUON Chea the day before. The Co-Prosecutors, the Civil Party Lead Co-Lawyers and the IENG Sary Defence expressed their comments. The Trial Chamber ruled that the Counsel were not allowed to directly request a doctor to examine their clients. Such a request could only be made through a *greffier*. The Counsel were further not allowed to personally attend medical examinations of the Accused.

## Observation of KHIEU Samphan Defence

Following the request of the Counsel for KHIEU Samphan, the Trial Chamber advised the Parties and the Witness to pause between the questions and the answers in order to facilitate the interpretation. The Witness should also avoid drawing any conclusions.

# Testimony of KAING Guek Eav

The Co-Prosecutors continued to put questions to the Witness.

#### Trial Chamber's reminder to the Parties

The Trial Chamber reminded the Parties to ask only those questions which are relevant to the first segment of the trial; that is questions which concern the relevant paragraphs of the Closing Order as determined by the Trial Chamber.

#### Waiver of the Accused's right to be present in the courtroom

The Accused IENG Sary and NUON Chea waived their right to be present in the courtroom.

### Clarification concerning the manner of presenting documents

The Trial Chamber reiterated that Parties should identify documents when presenting them before the Chamber. It ruled that if a witness is not familiar with a document, the document has to be removed from him or her as well as from the screen. However, any Party can put questions to the witness based on the subject-matter in the document.
