SUBMISSION

- 1. In relation to the upcoming Trial Management Meeting scheduled to begin on 11 December 2013, and further to the Co-Prosecutors' Submission Regarding the Scope of Case 002/02 and Trial Schedule filed on 5 December 2011, the Co-Prosecutors submit herewith as confidential Annex A a plan for the trial of the crime sites that were proposed for inclusion in Case 002/02, including a tentative or preliminary list of the witnesses, civil parties and experts that the Co-Prosecutors intend to request for each proposed crime site and trial segment. Annex A is filed at this time to assist the Chamber in evaluating the length of time that would be required for the trial of Case 002/02, if the crime sites and events proposed by the Co-Prosecutors were included, and to give the Chamber and parties an initial indication of the witnesses that may be requested by the Co-Prosecutors for such trial. The Co-Prosecutors note that their review and assessment of necessary witness testimony is ongoing, and a definitive witness list will be filed after the scope of Case 002/02 is determined and dates established by the Chamber for the filing of witness and document lists by all parties.
- 2. In addition to witnesses and civil parties relating to the proposed Case 002/02 crime base, Annex A includes witnesses and experts relating to the role of the Accused, existence of a Joint Criminal Enterprise and specific CPK policies who were not heard in the Case 002/01 trial. The suggested time allocation for each witness, civil party or expert appears in bold immediately prior to the name of the person. A total of 96 court days would be required for the hearing of the witnesses, civil parties and experts proposed by the Co-Prosecutors in confidential Annex A.
