### **SUBMISSION**

- 1. In response to paragraph 5 of the Trial Chamber's memorandum of 24 December 2013, which directs that "[a]ny written submissions on the scope of Case 002/02 are to be filed by 31 January 2014," the Co-Prosecutors hereby provide notice that their proposal regarding the scope of Case 002/02 remains as set forth in paragraphs 9 through 20 of their 5 December 2013 filing titled "Co-Prosecutors' Submission Regarding the Scope of Case 002/02 and Trial Schedule with Annex A."
  - 2. As detailed in that 5 December 2013 filing, the specific crime sites or events that are proposed for inclusion in Case 002/02 by the Co-Prosecutors are: (1) the S-21 Security Centre, including Choeung Ek; (2) Treatment of the Vietnamese (excluding Crimes Committed by the Revolutionary Army of Kampuchea on Vietnamese territory); (3) Treatment of the Cham (excluding the Kroch Chhmar Security Centre); (4) the Tram Kok Cooperatives and Kraing Ta Chan Security Centre, including Treatment of Buddhists and Forced Marriage; (5) the 1<sup>st</sup> January Dam Worksite; (6) the Kampong Chhnang Airport Construction Site; (7) Au Kanseng Security Centre; and (8) Phnom Kraol Security Centre.
- 3. The Co-Prosecutors reiterate that the scope of Case 002/02 must be determined in accordance with the directive of the Supreme Court Chamber that "Case 002/02 shall comprise at minimum the charges related to S-21, a worksite, a cooperative, and genocide."
