- II. Foreign Affairs in 1976
- 1. Continue inviting friendly countries to come to our country:
 - A. The nonaligned countries:

- Invite ambassador and minister level, sufficient missions, progressive mass organizations, especially from among African nations. As for Asians, do not yet invite them.
 - B. Socialist countries: China, Korea, Vietnam, Laos.

- Invite journalists to make one month trips. Push the Tonle Sap ទង្គេសាប.
- 2. Diplomatic activities outside the country:
 - A. High level delegations: Do not yet depart.
 - B. Preparation work:
- May: Go to participate in Algiers to prepare the Colombo Conference. High level only Foreign Ministry.
 - June: Prepare to receive the Vietnamese for negotiations.
- August: Prepare to participate in the Colombo Conference. High level will go: Chairman of Council of State or Chairman of the Assembly or the Prime Minister.
 - C. Our diplomats from overseas:
 - Must prepare a list by category, divided into four categories.
- This group, do not let them go back. If they go to work as assistants, alright, but they must be reeducated and used according to their specialties.
- 3. Preparations to receive visitors:
- Prepare houses in Siem Reap សៀមរាប Angkor អង្គរ, in Kampong Saom កំពង់សោម, in Kampong Thom កំពង់ធំ, in Battambang បាត់ដំបង.
- Educate security cadres and combatants both male and female to serve visitors in dining and transport, to be warm and friendly but always with high revolutionary vigilance.

- III. National Defense Affairs:
- 1. Weapons factories:
- Keep on striving further, and pep-are to assign suitable cadres, do whatever it takes to make progress.

- These factories must be set up quickly, but most quiet sites must be found so that the enemy cannot destroy them.
- Our objective is to serve the national defense. Therefore, we must prepare the line of activities quietly.
- 2. Military airfields:
- We will set up operations in Kampong Chhnang កំពង់ឆ្នាំង.
- We must to defend the country effectively.
- Whatever they want, we will do that. Some things we will buy in additional quantities.
- 3. Organizing the General Staff and the Air Force:
- Take Comrade San សាន for the air services.
- Based on this goal, must remove Comrade Tum § from Supply to the General Staff.
- Comrade San and Comrade Nath Mnn will only be General Staff cadres, moving around to assist in the General Staff in combat operations, and will not be in personal command of forces.
- Comrade Teanh ទាញ and Comrade Maut ម៉ូត will go to the factories.
- Artillery units or radar units. We may bring in regimental level cadres to train as we go.
- 4. Adding forces:

- Us the forces the Army has now, and the Standing Committee will meet to propose additional forces.
- 5. Preparing documents for negotiations with the Vietnamese on the border:

Comrade Secretary called to mind:

- The principles that the Standing Committee has designated on the solution to the borders to the East and along the waters with Vietnam and our important objectives in these negotiations.
- 6. Various problems with Vietnam:
- <u>The Indochina problem</u>: We have always wanted to end this matter. Therefore, there must be a way to explain this to the nonaligned countries.
- <u>Concerning human remains</u>: What Vietnam has demanded we will not give. But tactically we will be happy and intimate, saying we are now having difficulties, as are you our friends.
- <u>Civil aviation</u>: Propose that Foreign Affairs examine this and report to the Standing Committee.
- IV. On Commerce and Industry:
- 1. Regarding the Korean commercial delegation:
- Organize a committee to go negotiate with them: Comrade Vorn នៃ, Comrade Ân អន, Comrade Chey ជ័យ, Comrade Chhoeun ហេញីន.
- In the Office, as technical staff assistants: Comrade Văn វ៉ាន់, Comrade Hèm ហែម, Comrade Touch ទូច.
- 2. Regarding the Chinese commercial delegation:

- Organize a delegation to receive and negotiate: Comrade Doeun ឡើន, Comrade Krin គ្រិន, Comrade Say សាយ, Comrade Chhoeun ឃឿន Comrade Hok ហុក, one person from Foreign Affairs, Comrade Lamuth ឬត.
- 3. Industry and Railways:
- Propose that Industry build one water pump station at Daun Ky ដូនគឺ in the East Zone for experimentation.

- Distribute ten water pumps to the East.
- New railways now being set up. Propose organizing machinery from Agriculture to assist in this work with grading teams and rock handling teams.
- Young male and female combatant forces for textiles and machining/lathes. Send:

100 for machining/lathes

200 for textiles

V. Various matters:

- 1. <u>The matter of Party induction</u>: Circular to the bases to begin inducting into the Party on 1 May. If they join before that, that is alright as well.
- 2. Educating male and female youth surrounding 870:
- The Standing Committee down to the Ministries, it seems they must go to conference for one or two days each time.
- Set up meetings in the ministries once monthly.
- Implement celebration programs according to the calendar by setting up a joint meeting.
- 3. The Standing Committee will go down to the bases in May:

- Push expansion of rubber.
- Push early season rice, especially in the large zones like the Northwest, North, Southwest, and Siem Reap ហៀមរាប
- 4. Work with the various ministries:
- In ten governmental framework, meet once monthly.
- In individual ministerial frameworks, continue working as before.
- : To grasp the situation of the ministries in order to explain about the general stances of the Party and to provide timely instructions.

- 5. Prepare guest reception houses:
- Palace: For the Heads of State or Party Secretaries
- <u>Chamkar Mon</u> ចំការិមនៈ For Prime Ministers and Deputy Prime Ministers
- <u>House Number One</u>: For other delegations.
