SUBJECT:	Decision on the Khieu Samphan Defence Request for an Extension of AMBRE DE PRET Time Limit to Respond to the Co-Prosecutors' and Civil Party Lead Co Lawyers' Witness, Expert and Civil Party Internal Rule 87(4) Justifications	

1. On 30 July 2014, the Khieu Samphan Defence Team made an oral request during the further Initial Hearing for an extension of the time limit to respond to Internal Rule 87(4) submissions filed by the Co-Prosecutors and Civil Party Lead Co-Lawyers (E307/3/2 and E307/6). Further to the Trial Chamber's decision to allow the Co-Prosecutors and Civil Party Lead Co-Lawyers an extension of the page limit for these submissions (E307/3/1), the submissions are 42 and 30 pages respectively. The Khieu Samphan Defence Team argues that, given the extended lengths and timing of the submissions, it will require more than the usual 10 days (permitted under Article 8.3 of the *Practice Direction on Filing Documents before the ECCC*) to respond to the submissions and requests an extension of 10 days (T. 30 July 2014, pp. 105-106).

2. On 4 August 2014, the Trial Chamber informed the Parties by e-mail that it granted the Khieu Samphan Defence Team request. The Trial Chamber hereby confirms that the Khieu Samphan Defence Team is granted an additional 10 days to respond to E307/3/2 and E307/6.
