The Trial Chamber has been informed by the Khmer-Soviet Friendship Hospital that KHIEU Samphan will be discharged from hospital only on 15 January 2015. In view of this, the Chamber has asked me to inform you that the hearing scheduled for that day is cancelled. Pursuant to the established schedule, the next hearing day will be on 21 January 2015. The Chamber will continue with 2-TCW-936 on that date.

With respect to the request for a change to the seating arrangements in the courtroom, raised in court on 8 January 2015, the Trial Chamber rejects the request. The Chamber observes that this is an issue which concerns practical arrangements necessary to ensure the good conduct of the trial and which is not normally open to adversarial debate. However, the Chamber has heard the submissions of the Parties on this point and finds the Defence submissions to be unpersuasive.
