SUBJECT: Trial Chamber Judicial Recesses during 2015

- To assist in planning, the Trial Chamber informs the parties of the following judicial recess dates for 2015:
 - 13-17 April 2015 (Khmer New Year);
 - 11-15 May 2015 (King Norodom Sihamoni's Birthday);
 - 29 June -24 July 2015 (Mid-year recess);
 - 12-16 October 2015 (Pchum Ben);
 - 23-27 November 2015 (Water Festival);
 - 21 December 2015 1 January 2016 (Christmas/New Year)
- Time limits for filing documents shall run during the judicial recess.
- Whilst the above periods of judicial recess coincide to a large extent with the major Cambodian and international public holidays, the Chamber will also not sit on a number of other single days, comprising Royal Government of Cambodian public holidays. The dates of these additional public holidays were communicated by the Office of Administration in its Information Circular entitled "Official Holidays for 2015" of 13 November 2014, a copy of which is attached for ease of reference.
- The Chamber wishes to clarify that judicial recess periods are not holidays but days on which the Trial Chamber will not sit in Case 002/02. During these intervals, progress is made on decisions, and future trial phases are planned. The Parties may also use this time to familiarize themselves with any additional disclosure. Recess periods are also necessary to permit the judicial committees and plenary sessions to be convened, where required.
