## Telegram Nº 15

## Respectfully submitted to Beloved Comrade Brother Pol

We would like to report on the problems connected to the transfer of people from the East Zone to the North Zone. There were some disagreements and failure to follow Angkar's advice. At the sites for receiving people, the following incidents took place:

- On 30 November both sides agreed that the handover of people by the East Zone to the North Zone should take place in Stueng Trang (ស្ទីឯត្រង់) and in Preah Prasab (ព្រះ ប្រសព្វ). In Preah Prasab, the North Zone would receive those from Chhloung district, whereas Stueng Trang would receive those from Peam Chileang (ពាមជីហាំង) and

Krouch Chhmar ([fight]) districts. The sector and district authorities collected all of the people who were to be moved from Sector 21 and ferried them to the other side of the river. The two reception sites are categorically not taking Cambodians of Chamorigin, but only those of Cambodian origin. Therefore, the people who are to be moved on 30 [November] are in a state of utter agitation.

- I immediately advised the sector and <u>district authorities</u> to suspend <u>the move</u> temporarily pending advice from you and the North Zone. This matter might not have been <u>made</u> known to Comrade <u>Pork (Nñ)</u>. I <u>advised them</u> to take the <u>Cham</u> back to their home villages. The meeting decided that <u>we must not return the Cham</u> to Kratie. The Northwest <u>Zone</u> and the North <u>Zone</u> must <u>receive</u> them in order to separate them from the banks of the Mekong River <u>to ease tensions</u>. However, our comrades did not follow that decision. We therefore await your decision on this matter.
- In principle the Zone <u>must hand over fifty thousand [50,000]</u> people to the North Zone. In this regard, the remaining Cham in the East Zone amount to more than one

hundred thousand [100,000]. We have deported only the Cham from along the river and the border, but not from Tboung Khmum (nitual) district. The transfer is in principle designed to disperse the Cham as per our previous discussion. However, if the North Zone does not take the Cham, we are still willing to continue our endeavour to deal with them—no problem.

Nevertheless, the <u>population will not reach</u> one hundred and fifty thousand (150,000) if the North Zone does not <u>receive</u> the <u>Cham</u>.
