SUBJECT: Order Scheduling Cognitive Testing of the Accused

- On 9 June 2015, the Trial Chamber ordered the Medical Unit to administer quarterly cognitive testing of the Accused, NUON Chea and KHIEU Samphan, beginning no later than 31 August 2015 (E329/9, E329/9.1). Dr. Kin Ming CHAN, one of the Trial Chamber's appointed experts, subsequently met with two Medical Unit doctors regarding the administration of the Abbreviated Mental Test (AMT) developed for the required cognitive testing (E329/10, para. 4). The first tests were administered by both of these Medical Unit doctors on 7 August 2015.
- Dr. CHAN has informed the Trial Chamber that the current AMT may be used for a year. The Chamber considers it appropriate that future tests also be administered jointly by both Medical Unit doctors. The Chamber directs WESU to coordinate and schedule the next three quarterly tests during the following timeframes:
  - between 1 15 November 2015;
  - between 1 15 February 2016; and
  - between 1 15 May 2016.
- The Trial Chamber further orders the Medical Unit to submit to the Trial Chamber the results of each AMT as soon as possible after the respective tests.
