Dear Parties,

Considering the frequent changes in the order of witnesses and Civil Parties for the topic Treatment of Targeted Groups, the Chamber has asked me to circulate a combined list containing the remaining witnesses, Civil Parties and experts to be heard for the Treatment of the Vietnamese and the Cham. The list is attached for your convenience.

Please note that while 2-TCCP-869 and 2-TCCP-844 appear on the list, they will not be heard until further information is obtained in relation to their psychological and physical health. Further, following the Parties' oral submissions of 16 December 2015 in relation to 2-TCCP-234 and 2-TCCP-300, the Chamber has decided, in order to give the NUON Chea Defence an opportunity to clarify questions it raised concerning 2-TCCP-300, to call 2-TCCP-234. The Chamber has directed WESU to contact this Civil Party to establish when she would be available to travel to the ECCC. The Chamber will inform the Parties of the estimated date of appearance of this Civil Party as soon as it receives an update from WESU.

The Chamber has also decided to hear 2-TCW-1007 in relation to this topic and has directed WESU to contact the witness. The Chamber will notify the Parties of the estimated date of appearance in due course.

Consequently, after hearing 2-TCW-1000 and 2-TCW-848, the Chamber will move back to hearing witnesses and Civil Parties in relation to the Treatment the Cham in the order set out in the attached list.

On 3 September 2015, the KHIEU Samphan defence requested the Chamber to renounce calling on its own motion 2-TCW-987 as a witness. The Chamber has decided to hear 2-TCW-987 and will issue written reasons in due course.

Further, the Chamber is still considering whether to call one or more experts in relation to the Treatment of the Vietnamese.

A separate email has been sent in response to the Civil Party Lead Co-Lawyers' request for clarification in relation to the Treatment of Former Khmer Republic Officials trial topic. This list includes the one witness that will be heard on the topic.
