In the ongoing judicial investigation against Nuon Chea, Ieng Sary, Khieu Samphan and others, relating to charges of Crimes against Humanity and Grave Breaches of the Geneva Conventions of 12 August 1949, it is deemed necessary for you to appear as a witness because of, among other reasons, public statements you made in the past (in particular, on 13 December 2006).

This investigative action must be organised in light of the procedural formalities which the Co-Investigating Judges must respect (i.e., on the premises of the ECCC and naturally in closed session). Please find an official summons attached herewith. Also, I wish to inform you that the date mentioned on the summons is only indicative. In order to confirm this date or to set a different one should you not be available on the date indicated owing to your obligations, the Greffier of the Co-Investigating Judges will be in contact with your office in the coming days.
