- In its "Decision on Expedited Request of Co-Lawyers for a Reasonable Extension of Time to File Challenges to Jurisdictional Issues" dated 3 March 2008, the Pre-Trial Chamber indicated that Civil Parties would be notified of their rights in the current appeal after the rendering of the Decision on Civil Party Participation in Provisional Detention Appeals. This Decision was rendered on 20 March 2008.
- 2. The Co-Lawyers for the Defence filed "Ieng Sary's Appeal against Provisional Detention Order" on 15 January 2008 ("Appeal Brief"). On 7 April 2008, in accordance with the Pre-Trial Chamber's directions, the Co-Lawyers for the Defence filed "Ieng Sary's Submissions pursuant to the Decision on Expedited Request of Co-Lawyers for a Reasonable Extension of Time to File Challenges to Jurisdictional Issues" ("Submissions on Jurisdiction").

THEREFORE, THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER HEREBY DIRECTS:

The Lawyers for the Civil Parties to file a single response, if any, to the Appeal Brief and the Submissions on Jurisdiction, not exceeding 15 pages in English or French and 30 pages in Khmer, within 15 days of notification of these directions. A joint submission should not exceed 45 pages in English or French or 90 pages in Khmer.
