



Unrepresented Civil Parties




1. **THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER** of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (“ECCC”) notes the Charged Person’s Appeal against the Order on Extension of Provisional Detention dated 18 November 2009 (“Appeal”).
2. On 27 April 2010 the Pre-Trial Chamber scheduled a public hearing for the delivery of its decision on the Appeal on **30 April 2010 at 10:30** advising that a summary of the decision will be read out by the President of the Pre-Trial Chamber. Summons to the Charged Person and his Co-Lawyers were served on the same day.
3. On 30 April 2010 the Charged Person and his Co-Lawyers were not present for the hearing for pronouncement of the decision on Appeal.
4. The Charged Person had a right to attend, which he did not exercise upon basis that his Co-Lawyers were not available. The Pre-Trial Chamber did not receive any formal application to adjourn the hearing.
5. In light of this, on the same day of 30 April 2010, the Pre-Trial Chamber, reserving the Charged Person’s rights, directed that the Charged Person can make application to be heard on at least five days notice and that any such notice is to be given within 21 days from this day.
6. On 10 May 2010, the Charged Person submitted a request to be heard.
7. The Pre-Trial Chamber notes that there is no right of appeal in respect of the decision on the Appeal in this matter.

THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER HEREBY

SCHEDULES a public hearing for the 27th of May 2010 at 15:00 and advises that The Charged Person will have 15 minutes to be heard.
