- 1. **THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER** of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia ("ECCC") is seized of a request by the Co-Lawyers for the Civil Parties for protective measures ("Request") in the context of the Charged Person's Appeal against the Provisional Detention Order.
- 2. The Co-Lawyers for the Civil Parties request on behalf of three of the Civil Parties that their names not be mentioned in public and that they be redacted from the record, even if the Civil Parties speak personally. The Co-Lawyers request further that a number be assigned to each Civil Party to be used in public.
- 3. The Pre-Trial Chamber considers that the Civil Parties have made clear that they have an interest in not having their names made public during the hearing. Before the hearing the Pre-Trial Chamber was not informed of and was not aware of an interest of any other party in revealing the identities of the Civil Parties.
- 4. It was therefore decided before the hearing that the names of the Civil Parties mentioned in the Request would be kept confidential during the hearing as requested.
- 5. The need to assign pseudonyms to Civil Parties did not arise before the hearing as they are only allowed to speak through their lawyers as previously decided..

THEREFORE, THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER HEREBY DECIDES:

To grant the Request to keep confidential the names of the three Civil Parties seeking protective measures for the purposes of the hearing and decision on the appeal.
