Mr. IENG Sary, through his Co-Lawyers ("the Defence"), pursuant to Rules 84(1) and 87(3). hereby sets out his objections – in the attached Annex – to the admission of certain documents contained in the footnotes of the Closing Order which were read out in Court on 5 December 2011.<sup>1</sup> According to a 17 November 2011 memorandum from the Trial Chamber Senior Legal Officer,<sup>2</sup> paragraphs of the Closing Order relating to the historical background would be read out in court<sup>3</sup> and "the documents or other sources referred to in the footnote to each such paragraph shall, without further order, be deemed to be placed before the Chamber (Internal Rule 87(2) and (3))."<sup>4</sup> On 5 December 2011, Judge Cartwright clarified: "[t]hese documents, whether in the paragraph or in the footnotes, will be deemed to be put before the Trial Chamber unless there is a challenge to them. If there is objection to any of these documents, then time will be scheduled by the Trial Chamber to allow for that argument to occur."<sup>5</sup> The parties have not been provided with a specific time period in which to object to these documents, although it is possible that certain of these documents may overlap with the documents on parties' lists which are to be objected to by 5 January 2012.<sup>6</sup> Accordingly, the Defence submits these objections as soon as possible following the relevant paragraphs being read out in Court in order to assist the Chamber in determining the admissibility of these documents in an expeditious fashion. These objections are submitted subject to the proviso that the Defence is not in a position to assess authenticity. The Defence therefore objects to the admission of any document which is not demonstratively authentic or shown to be authentic by the party seeking to introduce it.

**WHEREFORE**, for all the reasons stated in the attached Annex, the Defence respectfully requests the Trial Chamber to REJECT the documents listed in the attached Annex.
