## The opinions and instructions of Angkar

- 1. Salt production:

- 2. The railroad:
- Propose setting it up. If locomotives from China cannot be purchased, we can take carriages to connect to our locomotives.
  - 3. Kirirum Hydrolectricity វារីអគ្គីសនីគីរីវម្បៈ
    - Propose pushing this work further.
  - 4. Yugoslavian aid ជំនួយយុហ្គាស្តាវី, three million dollars:
- Propose buying one million dollars of medicines, especially fever medication, disease fighting of all kinds, for example antibiotics, energy medications, serum, etc.
