1. On 18 March 2011, the defence for co-accused Ieng Sary filed its 'Ieng Sary's Request for Extension of Time to File His Lists of Documents and Exhibits' (Ieng Sary's Request), requesting the Trial Chamber to allow them to file their documents and exhibits list after the Co-Prosecutors and Civil Parties have presented their case at trial, or alternatively, to be provided an additional 60 days from the date the Trial Chamber has informed the parties as to the structure of the trial and the order of the topics which will be addressed.
2. The defence for Madame Ieng Thirith (Accused) herewith supports and adopts the arguments set out in Ieng Sary's Request for an extension of time in which to file the list of documents and exhibits. In the light of the arguments advanced, the defence requests that the Trial Chamber allow the defence to defer the filing of its documents and exhibits list until after the Co-Prosecutors and Civil Parties have presented their documents and exhibits lists. The defence respectfully requests the Trial Chamber to allow the defence an additional 45 days after receiving the Co-Prosecutors' and Civil Parties' documents and exhibits lists to file the defence documents and exhibits list, in order to ensure respect for the Accused's fair trial rights as guaranteed by Internal Rule 21 and various international human rights instruments the ECCC are bound to apply.
