I. INTRODUCTION

1. In accordance with the Practice Directive on Protective Measures, Civil Party Lawyers for Group 1 (CPG-1) respectfully request that the Supreme Court Chamber (SCC) lift the protective measures in place for E2/62 in Case 002.

II. BACKGROUND

- 2. Protective measures were previously ordered for E2/62 and applied throughout trial proceedings.² This decision ordered the non-disclosure of Civil Party E2/62's identity and identifying information.
- 3. E2/62, who is also a civil party in Case 002, waived her protective status in that case.
- 4. On 16 March 2011 CPG-1, through its intermediary, contacted E2/62 and she consented to having her protective status waived for the purposes of the appeal hearing and the remainder of the proceedings in Case 001.
- 5. Representatives of WESU were contacted on this same day and informed of her consent to waive her protective status.

III.REQUEST

6. In light of the above, CPG-1 respectfully requests the SCC to lift the protective measures applying to E2/62.
