- *Appeal: Decisions can be appealed before the Supreme Court Chamber*

Reserve: Mr. Sin Rith (Cam) Mr. Phillip Rapoza (UN)

- *Voting: Affirmative vote of 5 Judges*
- *Serves as both appellate chamber and final instance*
- *Appeal: No, final decisions on both issues of law and fact, i.e. the case is not to be returned to the Trial Chamber*

- *Conduct judicial investigations when sized by an introductory submission of the Co-Prosecutors*
- *Obligated to consider both incriminating and exculpatory evidence*
- *Power to question suspects and victims, to hear witnesses, and to collect evidence in accordance with procedures in force*
- *Issues warrants and orders, including a Closing Order which can seize the Trial Chamber*

- *Right to appeal decisions of the Trial Chamber*
