THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia,

BEING SEISED OF the Appeals lodged by the National Co-Prosecutor¹ and the Co-Lawyers for MEAS Muth,² on 5 April 2019 and 8 April 2019, respectively, against the Closing Order delivered by the International Co-Investigating Judge on 28 November 2018 in Case 003,³ and the Appeal lodged by the International Co-Prosecutor on 8 April 2019⁴ against the Order Dismissing the Case against MEAS Muth, delivered by the National Co-Investigating Judge on 28 November 2018 in Case 003⁵;

CONSIDERING that the briefing on appeal in this case is complete;

NOTING the submissions regarding the Hearing, in response to the Pre-Trial Chamber's Notice of 5 September 2019,⁶ filed by the Co-Lawyers for MEAS Muth⁷ on 11 September 2019, the International Co-Prosecutor⁸ on 13 September 2019 and the National Co-Prosecutor⁹ on 17 September 2019;

NOTING MEAS Muth's Notice of Intent to Exercise Right to Remain Silent and Waiver of Right to Attend Hearings on the Appeals against the Closing Orders, filed by the Co-Lawyers for MEAS Muth on 21 October 2019;¹⁰

HEREBY ORDERS that a hearing shall be held in the main courtroom on Wednesday 27 November 2019, Thursday 28 November 2019 and Friday 29 November 2019 and **INFORMS** the Parties that the timetable for the hearing shall be as follows:

Wednesday, 27 November 2019:

9:30 – 9:45	Introduction (fifteen minutes)
9:45 – 10:15	Report on the case by the bench (thirty minutes)
10:15 – 11:15	Appeal by the National Co-Prosecutor (one hour)
11:15 – 12:45	Pause (one hour and a half)
12:45 – 16:15	Appeal by the International Co-Prosecutor (three hours and a half)

Thursday, 28 November 2019:

09:30 – 12:00	Appeal by the National/International Defence Counsels (two hours and a half)
12:00 – 13:30	Pause (one hour and a half)
13:30 – 15:30	Response by the International Co-Prosecutor (two hours)

Friday, 29 November 2019:

9:30 – 11:00	Response by the National/International Defence Counsels (one hour and a half)
11:00 – 12:30	Questions by the Judges to the Parties, if the need arises. Notice and relevant information would be given on Thursday, 28 November 2019
	(one hour and a half)

ORDERS that, any dispense with personal appearance of the Charged Person will require submission of a request through his lawyers with sufficient demonstration of justification to the Chamber;

INFORMS that, attendance of the Charged Person by video-link may be offered by the Court, if necessary; and



DECIDES that the hearing will be held in public for the Introduction, the Report on the case by the bench and the Questions by the Judges to the Parties. The rest of the hearing will be *in camera*.
