MEMORANDUM

- TO:** Judge NIL Nonn, President of the Trial Chamber of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia and the Judges of the Trial Chamber
- SUBJECT:** Case 002/01 Reparation Update, *Project 1: National Remembrance Day* and *Project 3: Construction of a memorial in Phnom Penh to honor the victims of forced evacuations*
- REFERENCE:** Rule 23 *quinquies*(3)(b) of the Internal Rules of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia

The Lead Co-Lawyers write this memorandum in order to inform the Chamber of the completion of two Case 002/01 reparation projects endorsed by the Chamber in its Judgement, the National Remembrance Day (Project 1) and the Construction of a memorial in Phnom Penh to honor the victims of forced evacuations (Project 3).¹

With respect to Project 1, the Royal Government of Cambodia decided by Sub-Decree No. 19 dated 14 February 2018 (Annex A) that May 20 of each year will be the National Day of Remembrance and is recognized as an official national holiday. The National Day of Remembrance was celebrated this year on 20 May 2018.


Regarding Project 3, with the approval of the Phnom Penh Municipality, the project was to create a group of sculptures to be situated at the *Stat Chas* roundabout park in front of Bun Rany Hun Sen High School in Phnom Penh near the French Embassy in Cambodia.² As the Chamber relied on the approval of the Phnom Penh Municipality as to the location of the memorial in its decision on civil party reparations, the Lead Co-Lawyers wish to provide the Chamber with the following information.

The sculpture was inaugurated at the approved location on 7 December 2017 at an event hosted by the French Embassy in Cambodia. Twenty civil parties attended the event. The Phnom Penh Municipality subsequently relocated the sculpture to the Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum with the approval of the French Embassy (Annex B). Civil parties have been informed of the relocation of the memorial during subsequent civil party forums.
