Respected and Beloved Organization Be Informed that:

On 23 June 1977 ... the defense unit on duty at the Prey Kri cooperative, Kampung Luong district, Kampung Chhnang Sector detained 24 persons in the Phnum Khla vicinity, among whom there was one woman.

1. According to their responses, they came from Khvav village, Toek Chha subdistrict, Prey Chhor district, Kampung Cham province. Their intention was to flee to the Phnum Kulæn to find the contemptible Chantareangsei.

2. They had their three chiefs, too: Khan Tata [??], Khvav village cooperative Committee, whose duty was to transport rice to dacoits at Toek Chha along with the contemptible Set, the Deputy Secretary; the contemptible Yæm and the contemptible Khân were also their chiefs.

3. When they went surreptitiously on the run, there were altogether 32 person, but they had all split up, leaving only 24 persons.

4. Their period of flight is already 120 days. It is therefore proposed that the Organization please make contact with the North as to whether there have indeed been persons who fled or not. And what sort of measures will the Organization have taken?
