Soeur Vasi សៀ វ៉ាស៊ី alias Doeun ឌឿន (Arrested 16 February 1977)

My (Douen's ឌឿន) confession respectfully sent to the Party (confession dated 4 April 1977)

Doeun ឌឿន joined the revolutionary movement through the Khmer Revolutionary Youth Committee in 1961 while Doeun ឌឿន was studying in year one of the Preah Sihanouk College (Kampong Cham កំពង់ចាម) through Koy Thuon កុយ ធ្មួន (alias Thuch ធ្មុច or Khuon ឃ្មួន), then a professor at the Preah Sihanouk College. The Khmer Revolutionary Youth Committee which Khuon ឃ្មួន had set up at that time included - Leng Bun Song ឡេង ប៊ុនសុំ, Tin Kim On ទីន គីមហុង and Doeun ឌឿន. The Preah Sihanouk College students whom Khuon ឃ្មួន was educating at that time included for example Leng Bun Song ឡេង ប៊ុនសុំ (deceased), Cham Touch ចាម ទូច (no information), Chhoeung Veng Huong ឈឿង វេងហួង (no information), and Chan Sreang ចាន់ ស្រីហង់ (arrested).

After joining the Khmer Revolutionary Youth Committee, Khuon ឃ្មួន took him for training at the house of Peou ពៅ, a farmer (killed by the enemy). At that house at Prey Toteung ព្រៃ ទូទឹង, he said that the Khmer Revolutionary Youth organization had the duty of leading the people, especially the youth, in the struggle. Khuon ឃ្មួន told him that there were two resistance movements, the revolution and the people's movement, to which Khuon ឃ្មួន had given the secret names ការងារ ១ [Job 1] and ការងារ ២ [Job 2]. In 1963, Khuon ឃ្មួន assigned Douen ឌឿន to lead the base surrounding Kampong Cham កំពង់ចាម City. In 1965, he took responsibility for the textile factory. In 1966, he was removed and entered secret work. During 1966, Angkar called Khuon ឃ្មួន to study, and Khuon ឃ្មួន handed zone duties to Doeun ឌឿន in his place, not to Kân កន (Pok ពក) the Deputy Secretary because there were solidarity difficulties. In 1969, Zone 304 had four armed propaganda teams: Doeun ឌឿន controlled one team; Comrade Pok ពក one; Comrade Krom ក្រុំ one; and Comrade Soth សុទ្ធី one team.

In late 1970, Koy Thuon កុយ ធ្មន arrived in Zone 304, convened a broad conference for five days, and met to arrange the sectors and distribute work between themselves, meaning Thuch ធុច (Koy Thuon កុយ ធ្មន) as Zone Secretary, Pok ពក as Deputy Secretary responsible for Siem Reap សៀមរាប, Doeun ខៀន as member responsible for the upper Kampong Cham កំពង់ចាម sector, Sreng ស្រែង as member responsible for the lower Kampong Cham កំពង់ចាមក្រោម sector, Lean លាន as assistant responsible for Kampong Cham កំពង់ចាម City (deceased), and Soth សុទ្ធ as assistant for upper Kampong Cham កំពង់ចាមលើ sector (arrested). Thuch ធុច assigned Doeun ខៀន and Tech Kim On តិក គីមអុន as the liaison committee for contacts with Viet Nam. From 1972 until 1974, Doeun ខៀន was assigned to be the Kampong Thom កំពង់ធំ Sector Secretary, with Lun លន as Deputy Secretary, Un អុន as member, Sao សៅ as member, Srun ស្រួន as member, and Mit neary [female comrade] Yun យុន (Ty ទី) as member. In 1974, Doeun ខៀន arrived to assume responsibility for zone economics and commerce, with Doeun ខៀន as committee chairman, Soth សុទ្ធ (arrested) as Deputy for Commerce, Say សាយ as member, កែម Kêm as member, Khoem ខឹម (arrested) as member, Ngin ឆិន (arrested) as member, and Thau ថ្ម as member. After the liberation of Phnom Penh, Khuon ឃួន came to the zone to convene a meeting about arrangements for zone work, transfers of cadres, and a victory meeting and celebration. Khuon ឃួន announced the appointment of Comrade Pok ពក as Secretary of Zone 303, Sreng ស្រែង as Deputy Secretary, Tol តុល as member, Ngin ឆិន as member, Thau ថ្ម as member, Sy ស៊ី as member, and Seng សេង as member. Soth សុទ្ធ was appointed as Secretary of Sector 106. As for Douen ខៀន, Angkar had him move to work in Phnom Penh. At that time, Khuon ឃួន took a number of cadres to Phnom Penh, especially the artistic groups, the group from Office T-15, and the group who had served on the battlefield.

"My (Doeun's ខៀន) plans for treason in moving traitor forces to the office of Angkar, from the internal war until the present." (Confession dated 16-17 April 1977)

1969-70: The Party had Zone 304 select a number of middle class youth, male and female, to study politics and technology. Since Thuch ធុច was busy with work with Angkar, Doeun ខៀន was the person responsible for recruiting those forces and arranging their dispatch, with:

- 1 - Sêm សែម (arrested), Ouen អឿន (arrested), and Khân ខន, Âm អំ and Khon ខុន (the male youths)
- 2 - Yun យុន who was of Khuon ឃួន, Kheng ខេង (deceased), Sou ស៊ូ, and Teng តេង (young females)
- 3 - Chham ឆា (arrested), Yêm យ៉ែម, Kaet កើត (purged), Phâl ផល (purged) (middle class teachers)

Ouen អឿន, Sêm សែម, and Khân ឱន requested military studies. Yêm យ៉ែម, Kaet កែត, Chham ឆាំ, and Sou ស្ងី requested training to prepare them to become political cadres. Sang សាង and Teng តេង requested to study medicine. A number of these forces returned in 1970, Ouen អឿន for example. Oeun អឿន rushed back to give military training. Khuon ហ្មួន decided that a number of others should go with Angkar. Khuon ហ្មួន sent Sêm សែម to Angkar permanently. When Oeun អឿន arrived at Zone 304, since at that time there were only four armed propaganda teams (Zone militia), Angkar requested to borrow Oeun អឿន to help train the Southwest Zone military because the Southwest had many soldiers and had already organized into company level units. Ouen អឿន was in the Southwest until the coup, when he returned to 304. Thuch ធុច្ច arrived in Zone 304 during September 1970.

From 1970 until 17 April 1975: During this period, Angkar requested forces from 304 time after time to assist with work. The forces sent to Angkar included: Prach ប្រាច្ច and his wife and four to ten other yuvan យុវនិ [Translator - name for male members of the Cambodian Social Youth Movement] at Office K-1 in the forests. In 1974, Angkar sent Prach ប្រាច្ច and his wife back to 304. Say សាយ, now at Office K-1, was sent from Kampong Thom. Mon ម៉ុន, a yuvan in propaganda, was sent from Kampong Thom. Chhan ឆាន, today in defense at Office K-1, was sent from Kampong Thom. Mul មុល, a female, is now at Angkar's printing press at Office K-3. Prum ព្រុំ today is at the messenger office of Angkar as replacement for Ky គី.

From 17 April 1975 until the present: After the victory over Phnom Penh, Thuch ធុច្ច told Doeun ខឿន to assist Angkar's work in Phnom Penh along with him, and told him if he had any forces to bring a number of them along because Angkar was very short of forces, to bring office and zone forces. Doeun ខឿន brought two types of forces: First -- Mâm ម៉ម, the former Chairman of 304 Arts, Angkar sent to the Foreign Ministry; Keo កែវ, former member of the Arts Committee, Angkar sent to the Foreign Ministry; Run រុន, Angkar sent to the Foreign Ministry ; Mei Chan Bau មី ចាន់បូ to control Angkar's printing press; Chy ឈី helped at the printing press at the Assembly Office; Hêm ហែម was a driver at Office K-3 (later he was recalled); Hean ហ៊ាន drove at Office K-3 (later he was recalled); Eat អិត drove at Office K-3 (later he was recalled); Khean ហ៊ាន in logistics at Office K-3; Khaon ខោន was at Angkar's school with Phum ភុំ. The second force -- Mân ម៉ន in Land Transport (arrested); Chhon ឆុន in Energy (arrested); Hâng ហង់ in Energy (arrested); Sao សៅ in the Foreign Ministry; Phin ភិន in the Zone office (arrested). On the military side from 304 there were: Ouen អឿន (arrested); Soeung សឿង (arrested); Suong ស្ងួង (arrested); Nai ណៃ (arrested); Chhin ឈិន (arrested); and Sây សាយ (arrested). Those forces from 304

came to Phnom Penh to help Angkar organize included: Chhoeun ណឿន (arrested); Kêm កែម, Seng សេង, Kun គុណ, Keng កេង, temporarily at Commerce kept ready for whenever Angkar required them; Lun លួន, former Secretary of the Siem Reap - Uddor Mean Chey សៀមរាប ឧត្តរមានជ័យ Sector, was given by Angkar to the Foreign Ministry; Hak ហាក់, removed from Water Transport, was prepared to be sent to Angkar. Female cadres from Zone 304 sent to Phnom Penh included: Nuon នួន, the wife of Nhêm ញ៉ែម; Keo កែវ, the wife of Han ហាន; Yun យួន, the wife of Thuch ផុច; Roeun, (the wife of Doeun ឌឿន whom Angkar sent to the Foreign Ministry). Mân ម៉ន at Water Transport, Lun លួន, Seng សេង (arrested), Kun គុណ (arrested), Hak ហាក់, and Say សាយ were kept and prepared for a request to Angkar that they become ministry chairmen. Sao សៅ, Chhoeun ណឿន (arrested), Kêm កែម, Keng កេង (today at the Ministry of Commerce) kept and prepared for request to Angkar as diplomats. Chhon គុន (arrested), Hâng ហង់ (arrested), Phin ផិន (arrested) prepared to become technical cadres or specialist for the future, for example in Energy, Commerce, Agriculture, Warehouse. Aside from these, Doeun ឌឿន was preparing and setting up work in a number of ministries and was building traitors in various ministries surrounding Angkar, like Mân ម៉ន at Water Transport, Kun គុណ at sewing, Hak ហាក់ at the Technical School, and Say Norng Lorn សាយ នងលួន at T-2. These people had communication difficulties since they were with Vorn Vet វ៉ែត វ៉ែត. Forces sent to various ministries: Khim Teng Long ឃឹម តេងឡុង at Public Works (Phin ផិន was CIA too); Phoas ភាស់ at the Propaganda Ministry; Roeung រឿង went to the State Warehouse; There were three members at the Ministry of Agriculture: Chey ជែ (arrested), Seng សេង (arrested) who were already there as old network connections, but Savath សាវ៉ាត could not be contacted. Social Action assigned the female Sou. The Foreign Ministry was preparing to propose to Angkar that Chhoeun ណឿន (arrested) be a diplomat to China, Kêm កែម to Egypt, and Sao សៅ to Yugoslavia.

1969-1970: The Party had Zone 304 select members of the Socialist Youth Movement and a number of middle class to study politics and technology. Since Thuch ផុច was busy with work with Angkar, I arranged the dispatch of traitorous forces as follows: The socialist youth members: Sêm សែម (arrested); Oeun អឿន (arrested), Khân ខន, Âm អំ, Khon ខុន. The females: Yun យួន, Kheng ខេង (deceased), Sou ស៊ូ, Teng តេង. The middle class teachers: Chham ធំ (arrested), Yêm យ៉ែម, Kaet កើត (purged), Phâl ផល (purged).

From 1970 until 17 April 1975: Prach ប្រាច្ឆ and wife, now at agriculture at 303; Chhan ឆាន, today in Office K-1 Defense; Say សាយ, today at Office K-1; Mul មុល (female), typist at K-3; Mân ម៉ាន at Propaganda.

17 April 1975 until the present: Mâm ម៉ម, Keo កែវ, Run រុន (from 304 Arts), was given by Angkar to the Foreign Ministry; Prum ព្រុំ, responsible for Angkar's messenger office (in Ky's គី place); Chham ឆា at the Assembly (arrested); Mei Chan Bau មី ចាន់បូ at Angkar's printing press (arrested); Yang យ៉ាង at K-3; Saroeun សារ៉េន, driver at K-1; Hean ហ៊ាន, driver at K-3 (later recalled since he was not satisfied with driving); Hêm ហែម, driver at K-3 (recalled); Khean ហ៊ាន logistics at Office K-3; Khaon ខោន at the Party School with Phum ភូ; Eat អិត, driver at K-3 (recalled).

Setting up the committee of treason at the office of Angkar in late 1976: Sêm សែម was in general charge; Prum ព្រុំ the Deputy; Chhan ឆាន a member; Yang យ៉ាង a member; The Defense Sub-committee: Sêm សែម was general Chairman; Chhan ឆាន the Deputy Chairman for Office K-1; Yang យ៉ាង, member in charge at K-3. The Sub-committee Responsible for Logistics and Messengers: Prum ព្រុំ in general charge; Yang យ៉ាង the Deputy; Khean ហ៊ាន a member. The subcommittee on defense units at Office K-1: Chhan ឆាន in general charge; Saroeun សារ៉េន, the Deputy; Say សាយ, a member. The Sub-committee on Defense Units at K-3: Yang យ៉ាង, the Chairman; Khean ហ៊ាន, member; Pheng ផេង a member (later recalled). Persons appointed to political and ideological work scattered throughout various production units: Hean ហ៊ាន, Hêm ហែម, Eat អិត, Pheng ផេង. Chhy ឈី at the Assembly (arrested), Khaon ខោន at the school.

Sub-committee Responsible for Printing Presses and Documents: Mei Chan Bau មី ចាន់បូ, Chairman; the female Mul មុល, member.

On contacts with the leaders of the traitor movement (dated 24 April 1977)

The committee to train and lead treason, 1970-71:

1. Ya យ៉ា, temporary chairman in general charge and with contacts with Viet Nam.
2. Chong ចុង, Southwest, deputy chairman, responsible for the bases and contacts with Thai officials.
3. Thuch តុច, North, member responsible for the bases and contacts with the CIA.
4. Mei Phau មី ផូ, from the North, member in charge of the group from the North and contacts with Viet Nam along with Ya យ៉ា.

5. Leav Keomony លាវ កែវ មុនី, from the North, member responsible for contacts with and control of the group from the North.

The committee to lead treason, 1971 through 15 April 1975.

1. Keo Meas កែវ មាស, chairman, responsible for contacts with Viet Nam.
2. Ya យ៉ា, deputy chairman for support bases.
3. Thuch ធុច, member responsible for bases in 304 and CIA contacts.
4. Mei Phau មី ផ្លូ, controlled the group from the North and contacts with Viet Nam.
5. Leav Keomony លាវ កែវ មុនី, controlled the group from the North
6. Ros Samoeun រស់ សាម៉េន, responsible for bureau
7. Doeun ឌឿន, member, responsible for bases in 304 and helping with bureau work.
8. Chhouk ឈួក, responsible for bases work, Sector 104
9. Chey Suon ជឿ សួន, responsible for bases work in Sector 25
10. Sreng ស្រែង responsible for base work in Zone 304.

Meeting at Tamak pagoda វត្ត តាម: , April 1976 (6 May 1977)

Early in the 1976 season the enemy was active in raiding to seize weapons from the militia, combatants, male and female, and cadres on guard in the forests, conducting bandit activities, ambushing the military, shooting the people, etc. Angkar called a meeting to examine the situation and take a number of urgent measures. After the meeting ended, Doeun ឌឿន decided to write a letter to Sreng ស្រែង and have a messenger personally deliver it to him, telling Sreng ស្រែង to prepare a place at Tamak តាម: pagoda for a two day meeting, instructing secrecy so comrade Pok ពក would not know.

Those who attending the meeting at Tamak pagoda វត្ត តាម:

Before starting on the trip, Doeun ឌឿន met with Khuon ហួន, who requested he bring up that the situation was good for our traitor forces and about the possibility of seizing state power from Angkar. During the meeting, importance was placed on speaking about this point, with three agendas: The political situation of the traitor movement: Preparations for seizing power from the Party in June 1976 according to the conditions in the countryside and city in participating in taking power from the Party; The task of the rural areas, and contacts with Viet Nam. He said his group had six divisions and had forces imbedded in the major ministries preparing political struggle to support the military compared to Angkar's forces who were not ready. Finally, the meeting agreed on all points which were raised and determined to make this materialize in the month of June.

On introducing CIA links from various places to Doeun when the Party assigned him to come in to be Chairman of the Office of Angkar (Date 21 April 1977)

Zone 303: Sreng ស្រែង, Chairman; Tol តុល, Deputy; Chên ចិន, member; Taing តាំង, member. The Siem Reap - Uddor Mean Chey សៀមរាប ឧត្តរមានជ័យ Sector: Soth សុទ្ធ, in general charge; Hean ហ៊ាន, Deputy; Sean ស៊ាន, member. The Mondulkiri Sector (106): Mei មី. In Kampong Saom កំពង់សោម: Nhem ញ៉ែម in general charge (arrested), Chhoeun ឈឿន (arrested); Vuth វុធ, member (arrested); Mol ម៉ុល, member. Phnom Penh: Thuch ផុច, in general charge; Chhoeun ឈឿន, Deputy (arrested); Mi មី, member; Phin ភីន, member. Other than these there were: Phoas ភាស់ and Mân ម៉ន in Propaganda; Phin ភីន in Public Works; Chey ជ័យ in agriculture. In the Front were: Sâm សំ (Krin Lean គ្រិន លាន), through Hak ហាក់, was to contact those outside. From Kampong Thom កំពង់ធំ: Lun លុន (at the Ministry of Industry) in general charge; Chhân ឆន (in Division 310), member. In the Ministry of Economics and Commerce of Zone 304: Say សាយ in industry; Kêm កែម (diplomat in Laos). Sector 24 had Chhouk ឈួក as chief. After June 1976, Doeun ឌឿន set up two committees to research and find traitor forces with whom contact had been broken off: (1) The Committee to Research Combatants, male and female: Chhoeun ឈឿន was Chairman; Chhon ឆុន, Deputy; and Hâng ហាំង was member. (2) The Committee to Research Intellectuals and Middle Class: Chey ជ័យ, Phoas ភាស់, and Kêm កែម.

The plan after the liberation of Phnom Penh and the actual work instructed by Khuon ឃ្មុន

After the liberation of Phnom Penh, Khuon ឃ្មុន returned to the Zone and called a meeting of the Zone Committee about zone work and transfer of cadres and about the victory meeting and celebration. Khuon ឃ្មុន announced the appointment of:

- Comrade Pok ពក, Secretary of Zone 303
- Comrade Sreng ស្រែង, Deputy Secretary of Zone 303
- Tol តុល, member
- Ngin ឃីន, member
- Thau ថ្នូ, member
- Sy ស៊ី, member
- Seng សែង, member
- Soth សុទ្ធ, Secretary of Sector 106

As for Comrade Doeun ឌឿន, Angkar called him to work in Phnom Penh.

Also, Khuon ហ្នួន removed a number of cadres to take them to Phnom Penh with him, especially the arts groups, the group of Office T-15, and those who served the work on the battlefield.

Research to link up traitor networks in the West Zone (Responses dates 25 April 1977)

On 2 February 1977, Doeun ឌឿន met with Sy ស៊ី, Secretary of the West Zone at the Kampong Luong កំពង់ឆ្នាំង office (near Prék Kdam ព្រែកក្តាម) to request 100 persons to cut or take out. Sy ស៊ី told him that there had been screening of much of the leadership by taking them to rest at the offices in the zone, sectors and districts, and not keeping them in the cooperatives, and he informed him about the arrest of Keo កែវ in Sector 15 and that Hâm ហម had been taken to carry out work at the Foreign Ministry. Sy ស៊ី told Doeun ឌឿន to tell Angkar not to allow Hâm ហម to be a diplomat, because if he went he clearly would run off and not return, since Hâm ហម was a traitor and did not follow the Party. Doeun ឌឿន understood that these screened forces were counter-revolutionary and he had to know them and grasp these forces without fail.

On 12 February 1977, when Angkar assigned him the responsibility of signing an Agreement on Economic Cooperation and Commerce with Yugoslavia, Doeun ឌឿន met Hâm ហម who was in attendance as a representative of the Foreign Ministry as introduced by Chey Suon ជឿ សួន. Hâm ហម told Doeun ឌឿន about the West Zone organization having already done the screening, and Hâm ហម asked how else the traitor forces had to be prepared. Doeun ឌឿន and Hâm ហម agreed to use the Sré Prang ស្រែប្រាំង agricultural site East of Prék Ta Tèn ព្រែកតាទែន - Tonle Sap ទន្លេសាប which was located behind the old Sector 15 Office which had boundaries adjacent to Sector 41 of Zone 303 and Sector 22 of Zone 203, to carry out treasonous activity because it was easy to contact three sectors and the work force at this work site were all embedded traitors and upper level people from Phnom Penh.

He contacted Hâm ហម this one time, and on 16 February 1977 Angkar arrested him.
