Instruction for 164

Telegram 10 dated 4 November 1976

To beloved and missed Comrade Mut:

1. I have already received your telegram No.16-07-08.
2. Concerning the enemy situation in the west, overall, there don't have any serious possibility. For example, in military field, domestic and overseas policy, they are curbing revolutionary strength inside their countries, and the world's (revolutionary strength).

For their activity, through our examination, they had launched some attacks in order to protect themselves.

For our standpoint, [we] must absolutely destroy them at any time when they [illegally] entered our maritime as well as land territories.

For example, in Koh Krasar, [we] must have some forces to examine so as to take any measures to destroy them if they had really deployed troops there. During examination, we make a preparation carefully and thoroughly.

For Koh Ya and Koh Kong, [we] must also plan to attack if they come closer, especially, must be careful and make a protective system for Koh Wai, Koh Pring, Koh Tang in case that they take risk.

3. Please agree with the measures raised by comrade in telegram 08.
[I] want to add some more. Must have a constant contact by Te O (two-way radio device), and in this emergent situation, wind-radios can be used in order to be self-dependent for making contact every single minute. But must use codes and secret scripts all the time.
4. For those in the west who had been arrested in Koh Hawai, must keep this [issue] secret. And must prepare and ready to attack in case that their troops chase.
5. For the East, must have a good grasp and examination to see what is the cause of their fighting in Koh Tral.
6. The overall situation throughout the country has remained unchanged. The East [group] also hasn't yet been self-controlled.
7. For the motor-boats which have already been made, I will ask Angkar to go and take.
8. For cement, [we] also can decide. Wait until comrade Tum issue a letter [of authorization] to take it.

9. Please grasp the situation more. If there is nothing unusual, [you] can come. When [you] have arrived here, [we] will examine the situation and decide whether to send any comrades to go and station.
10. Thank you for sending fish. It has already been sent to hospital [house for treatment] and school.
