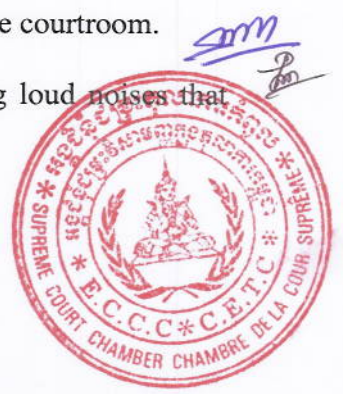

**Internal Regulations  
Governing the Courtroom on Hearing Days**

In order to ensure the public order, security and the effective functioning of the courtroom during hearings of the Supreme Court Chamber, the President of the Supreme Court Chamber has established the following internal regulations governing the courtroom on hearing days:

1. All persons who wish to attend a hearing shall be present in the courtroom of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (“ECCC”) by 8.30am for morning sessions and by 1.15pm for afternoon sessions.
2. Participants and persons in the public gallery shall stand when the greffier announces, “Stand”, and sit when the President of the Supreme Court Chamber announces, “Sit down”.
3. Participants shall maintain dignity and proper behaviour in the courtroom at all times. Participants shall wear appropriate clothing. Their clothing may not display slogans, indicate their support for a party of the proceedings, or be otherwise offensive in any way. Banners and posters will not be permitted in the courtroom.
4. All cameras, camcorders, tape recorders, and loudspeakers are prohibited in the courtroom, except as approved by the President of the Supreme Court Chamber.
5. Smoking or bringing food or drinks inside the courtroom is prohibited.
6. All weapons, explosives, ammunitions and inflammable substances are prohibited inside the courtroom, except for those carried by the ECCC’s authorised security-guards.
7. The use of cell phones is strictly prohibited. Phone cameras and phone audio recordings are also prohibited, except as approved by the President of the Supreme Court Chamber.
8. All persons are prohibited from changing seats or walking freely inside the courtroom.
9. All persons are prohibited from clapping, cheering, shouting or making loud noises that might disrupt the hearing.



10. Permission must be granted by an ECCC authorised security guard in order to enter or exit the courtroom.
11. Children under 16 years of age are prohibited from entering the courtroom. Persons between 16 and 18 years of age may enter the courtroom if they are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, unless they are attending the hearing as civil parties or witnesses.
12. Pursuant to the Internal Rules of the ECCC and the applicable laws of the Kingdom of Cambodia, the President of the Supreme Court Chamber may take preventive measures or direct action against any person who breaches these Internal Regulations.
